**SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE ANNUAL PAVEMENT MARKING
CONTRACT NO. 2013055
DATED JULY 2, 2013, BY AND BETWEEN
SOUTHWIDE INDUSTRIES, INC.,
AND PALM BEACH COUNTY**

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT to the Annual Pavement Marking Contract dated July 2, 2013, (R2013-0810), hereinafter "CONTRACT" by and between Southwide Industries, Inc., hereinafter "CONTRACTOR" and the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the state of Florida, hereinafter, "COUNTY".

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, on July 2, 2013, the CONTRACTOR and COUNTY entered into a eighteen month Annual Pavement Marking Contract for furnishing and installing pavement marking material, raised pavement markers and traffic paint on roadways throughout Palm Beach County; and

WHEREAS, the CONTRACT provides that the contract may be extended, at the COUNTY's option for a defined period of time, not to exceed thirty-six months total contract time, upon approval of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, by this amendment, the CONTRACTOR and the COUNTY mutually agree to amend the CONTRACT terms to extend the expiration date of the CONTRACT with all original terms, conditions and unit prices adhered to.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, and agreements herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

1. The above recitations are true and correct and incorporated herein.
2. The CONTRACT, between the CONTRACTOR and the COUNTY is hereby amended to extend the expiration date of the CONTRACT from January 1, 2016 to July 1, 2016.
3. It is the intent of the parties hereto that this Amendment shall not become binding until the date executed by the COUNTY.
4. All other provisions of the Annual Pavement Marking Contract dated July 2, 2013, shall remain in full force and effect.






