I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Contract with Johnson-Davis, Inc. for the Aerial Crossing Replacements in Belle Glade in the amount of \$721,542.

Summary: On August 19, 2015, four (4) bids were received for the Aerial Crossing Replacements in Belle Glade (Project). The Project provides for the replacement of six (6) aerial canal crossings in four (4) different locations within the City of Belle Glade. The Project also includes the interconnection of transmission and distribution water pipes and the extension of a wastewater main under State Road 715 (SR 715) and Hooker Highway (SR 80). These improvements are part of the continued restoration and repair of water infrastructure in the Glades Region. Johnson-Davis, Inc. was the lowest responsive responsible bidder in the amount of \$721,542. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15% overall. The contract with Johnson-Davis, Inc. provides for SBE participation of 15.42% overall, as confirmed by the Office of Small Business Assistance. Johnson-Davis, Inc. is a Palm Beach County company. This project is included in the FY16 Capital Improvement Plan adopted by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC). (WUD Project No. 14-092) <u>District 6</u> (MJ)

Background and Justification: The Water Utilities Department has determined that aerial crossings for four (4) water mains and two (2) wastewater mains need to be replaced based on the deterioration of the structural supports of the pipes crossing six (6) canals in Belle Glade. Pipes at the aerial crossings are sub-standard and leaking at the joints in certain locations.



The bid opening for the above referenced project was held on Wednesday, August 19, 2015. Proposals were received from four (4) contractors. The complete Bid Tabulation is attached. The Engineer's opinion of probable construction cost was \$800,000.00. The low bidder is Johnson-Davis, Inc with a construction cost of \$721,542.00 for the bid.

An evaluation of the low bid by Johnson-Davis, Inc is as follows:

- 1. The first low bidder, Johnson-Davis, Inc, provided properly executed Bid Forms in the Contract Documents.
- 2. Bid security equal to 5% of the total base bid was enclosed with the bid.
- 3. SBE-M/WBE Schedules #1 and #2 were properly filled out. Johnson-Davis, Inc has met the 15% SBE goal established under the SBE Ordinance. The Compliance Review completed by the Office of Small Business Assistance (copy attached) states that Johnson-Davis, Inc has met the SBE goal with a 15.42% SBE participation for this project.
- 4. The County Attorney (CAO) has reviewed the bid and Bid Review Comments for the three (3) lowest bids. For Johnson-Davis, Inc, no major irregularities were identified. (See attached Bid Review Comments from CAO).
- 5. There were no addenda issued for this project.

- 6. Johnson-Davis, Inc holds valid general contractor and occupational licenses. Johnson-Davis, Inc had a valid Palm Beach County business tax receipt at the time of the bid submittal (See attached Palm Beach County Tax Collector receipt).
- 7. The first low bidder, Johnson-Davis, Inc, does have a permanent place of business in Palm Beach County. The contractor holds a valid state and Palm Beach County contractor's license. A copy of the license information is included.

The overall experience, qualifications, resources and references of the low bidder were carefully considered when evaluating the bids. Contract award is recommended to the lowest responsive bidder, Johnson-Davis, Inc, in the amount not to exceed \$721,542.00 for the bid, subject to formal approval by the PBC Board of County Commissioners. A copy of this notice has been posted at the bid opening location and will be left there for a minimum of five (5) business days.


