I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 15 for the CD06 Congress Avenue Force Main Extension (Project) with Holtz Consulting Engineers, Inc. in the amount of \$118,329.42.

Summary: On June 3, 2014, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Water Utilities Department (WUD) Engineering/Professional Services Contract with Holtz Consulting Engineers, Inc. (R2014-0825). CSA No.15 provides survey, location, design, and permitting services for the design of approximately 4,600 linear feet of force main improvements along Congress Avenue between Forest Hill Boulevard and Kentucky Street in West Palm Beach. The Project will facilitate the provision of wastewater services of small businesses along Congress Avenue. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15% overall. The contract with Holtz Consulting Engineers, Inc. provides for SBE participation of 100%. CSA No. 15 includes 100% participation. The cumulative SBE participation including this authorization is 98.88% overall. Holtz Consulting Engineers, Inc. is a Palm Beach County company. This project is included in the FY16 Capital Improvement Plan adopted by the BCC. (WUD Project No. 15-097) District 2 (MJ)

Background and Justification: Various small businesses along Congress Avenue between Forest Hill Boulevard and Kentucky Street currently utilize individual septic tanks with drain fields to dispose of generated wastewater. The County provides wastewater utilities near this area with small diameter force mains and gravity mains generally located on the west side of Congress Avenue. CSA No. 15 will provide surveying, location, engineering design, and permitting services for the design of a force main collection system of approximately 4,600 linear feet along Congress Avenue between Forest Hill Boulevard and Kentucky Street to allow the small businesses currently on septic tanks in the area to connect to the County's wastewater collection system.

PALM BEACH COUNTY WATER UTILITIES DEPARTMENT ENGINEERING/PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

SCOPE OF WORK FOR CONGRESS AVENUE FORCE MAIN EXTENSION

INTRODUCTION

Palm Beach County (COUNTY) entered into an agreement entitled Contract for Engineering/ Professional Services - Palm Beach County Utilities Department Project No. WUD <u>14-005</u> (CONTRACT) with: <u>Holtz Consulting Engineers, Inc.</u> (CONSULTANT) to provide engineering services for various general activities on (Reference Document <u>R2014-0825</u>). This Consultant Service Authorization will be performed under that CONTRACT.

This Consultant Services Authorization encompasses providing services related to the survey, underground utility locates, design, and permitting services for approximately 4,600 linear feet of force main improvements along Congress Avenue in West Palm Beach from Forest Hill Boulevard, north to Kentucky Street to serve the small businesses along Congress Avenue with public sewer. A more detailed description of the scope is presented below.

BACKGROUND

Congress Avenue between Forest Hill Boulevard and Kentucky Street is located in central Palm Beach County. There are various small businesses along Congress Avenue that currently have individual septic tanks and drain fields to dispose of generated sewage. The COUNTY provides wastewater utilities to this area from small diameter force mains and gravity mains generally located on the west side of Congress Avenue. The COUNTY has requested the services of the CONSULTANT to perform land surveying, underground utility locates, engineering design, and permitting services for the design of a force main collection system of approximately 4,600 linear feet along Congress Avenue between Forest Hill Boulevard and Kentucky Street to connect the small businesses currently on septic tanks to the COUNTY'S sewer collection system.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

CONSULTANT shall perform the engineering Scope of Services as described herein.

Task 1 – Surveying Services

Under this task, SUB-CONSULTANT, Lidberg Land Surveying, Inc. will perform a topographic survey of the project areas to be used for the design of the force main improvements. The survey will depict the following:

A. Topography survey at major ground elevation changes to depict existing ground profile at proposed project area. All topographical surveys shall have stationing established from south

to north and west to east. This shall be accomplished by creating a baseline in the field to collect pertinent data which shall include the following:

- Obtain horizontal and vertical control for this Project using information published by the Palm Beach County Survey Department utilizing State Plane Coordinates for horizontal control and the North American Vertical Datum of 1988 (NAVD 88) for vertical control.
- 2. Location of visible fixed improvements within the existing road right-of-ways, including physical objects, roadway pavement, driveways, sidewalks, walls, curb, drainage swales, trees, signs, fences, power poles, and buildings.
- 3. Location of above ground existing utilities: FP&L, BellSouth, Cable TV, Natural Gas, Potable Water (valves, fire hydrants, and meters), Force Mains (valves), Sanitary Sewer, Reclaimed Water Mains (valves), Storm Sewers. Including invert elevations, pipe size, type and direction for storm and sanitary infrastructure.
- 4. Location of flagged and located below-ground utilities. Locating services will be performed under Task 2 of this Authorization.
- 5. Elevations shall be indicated at 50 foot stations, at a minimum, to indicate existing grades. Intermediate grades shall be indicated at all significant grade breaks.
- 6. Provide and reference site benchmarks. Elevations to be referenced to an existing established City or County Benchmark.

Task 1 Deliverables:

1. Provide three (3) plots of the drawings signed and sealed by a registered land surveyor at 1" = 20' scale and a computer disk with survey and drawing information compatible with AutoCAD Civil 3D Version 2015.

Task 2 - Utility Locating Services

Under this task, SUB-CONSULTANT, Ground Hound Detection Services, Inc. will perform utility locating services of the project areas to be surveyed for the design of the force main improvements. This task includes the creation of a Sunshine One Call design ticket and the coordination with the listed utilities.

Task 3 - Design

Under this task, CONSULTANT will design force mains, service tees, manhole rehabilitations, and all associated appurtenances that will connect into PBCWUD's sewer collection system.

- 3.1 The CONSULTANT will provide enginering services consisting of preparation of detailed Plans and Specifications depticting the installation of the five proposed force main segments to service the small buisnesses along Congress Avenue. These five segments are as follows:
 - 3.1.1 The first proposed force main segment will be a 4-inch force main on the east side of Congress Avenue from Forest Hill Boulevard, north to two lots north of Cherokee Road. This 4-inch force main will be located under the eastern-most lane of traffic and a 6-inch tee-branch off the 4-inch force main will cross Congress Avenue at Creek Road through an existing 12-inch casing and connect to an existing manhole on the north side of the Forest Hill Center shopping plaza. There is an existing lift station on the east side of Congress Avenue which has a 2-inch discharge force main that currently runs through the existing 12-inch casing under Congress Avenue. The existing 2-inch force main will be tied into to the proposed 4-inch force main and the section of the existing 2-inch force

main located within the 12-inch casing will be disconnected, removed and properly disposed of. (1,200 feet in length)

- 3.1.2 The second proposed force main segment will be a 4-inch force main extension on the east side of Congress Avenue from the existing 4-inch force main main south of Oak Drive, across Oak Drive to the existing buisness located on the northwest corner. The proposed 4-inch force main will be installed in the eastern-most lane of Congress Avenue. (200 feet in length)
- 3.1.3 The third proposed force main segment will be a 4-inch force main on the west side of Congress Avenue from Oak Drive, north to Collin Drive and west along Collin Drive to an existing manhole where the force main will be connected to. The proposed force main will be installed in the western-most lane of Congress Avenue and the southern-most lane of Collin Drive. The manhole that is being connected to will be rehabilitated after connection. (1,800 feet in length)
- 3.1.4 The fourth proposed force main segment will be a 4-inch force main on the east side of Congress Avenue from Holly Road, north to Summit Boulevard, then west across Congress Avenue and continuing along the south side of Summit Boulevard to connect to an existing manhole west of Congress Avenue. The proposed 4-inch force main will be installed in the eastern-most lane of Congress Avenue. The crossing of Congress Avenue at Summit Boulevard will be performed via horizontal directional drill methods. The 4-inch force main will be installed under the south sidewalk on Summit Boulevard and the manhole being connected to will be rehabiliated after connection. (1,000 feet in length)
- 33.1.5 The fifth proposed force main segment will be a 4-inch force main on the east 3.1.5 The fifth proposed force main segment will be a 4-inch force main on the east side of Congress Avenue from one lot north of Summit Boulevard, north to connect to the existing 4-inch force main. The proposed force main will be installed in the easternmost lane of Congress Avenue. (400 feet in length)

CONSULTANT will make site visits to to ensure the plans accurately reflect above grade existing site conditions on the plans. COUNTY aerial photos will also be utilized to aid in the preparation of the engineering base drawings to be used in the plans. Palm Beach County standard typical details will be utilized to prepare the project plans. The COUNTY's Minimum Design & Construction Standards will be supplemented with the CONSULTANT's standard specifications as applicable to the project for preparation of the project technical specifications to be included in the bidding documents.

3.2 Approximately twenty (20) design drawings will be provided for this project. Plan and profile sheets will be prepared at a 1"= 20' horizontal scale and 1" = 4' vertical scale. Conflict resolutions will be provided in callout boxes. The preliminary drawing list is as follows:

3.3 The CONSULTANT will provide three (3) full size (24" x 36") sets and one (1) half size (11" x 17") set of plans (plan view only) for review and comment by the COUNTY at the 30% complete stage for approval of the proposed force main location and layout. The CONSULTANT will provide three (3) full size (24" x 36") sets and one (1) half size (11" x 17") set of plans for review and comment by the COUNTY at the 60% complete stage that incorporate the COUNTY's comments on the 30% submittal. The submittal will also include a complete draft of the technical specifications sections with the 60% complete submittal. The CONSULTANT will provide three (3) full size (24" x 36") sets and one (1) half size (11" x 17") set of plans for review and comment by the COUNTY at the 90% complete stage that incorporate the COUNTY's comments on the 60% submittal. The submittal will also include a complete draft of the technical specifications sections with the 90% complete submittal that incorporate the COUNTY's comments on the 60% submittal. The CONSULTANT will provide CAD files and PDF files of the final (100% complete) drawings and "Word" files and one set of un-bound technical specifications and a bid schedule for preparation of scope of work sets. The CONSULTANT will provide the COUNTY three (3) full size (24" x 36") signed-and-sealed sets of final plans and three (3) signed-and-sealed copies of the technical specifications upon final completion for COUNTY's use.

3.4 Assumptions:

- It is assumed that the installation of the individual sewer services on private property upstream of the service box to connect to the individual homes and disconnect of the septic tanks are not part of this project and will not be depicted on the engineering plans.
- 2. No hydraulic modeling is included as part of this effort. Main line sizes will be directed by the COUNTY.
- **3.** Any improvements needed to the existing COUNTY lift stations will be performed by COUNTY staff and are not part of this project.
- **4.** Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) Plans are not part of this project. The Contractor wuill be responsible for developing, submitting, and obtaining approval of the MOT Plans.

Task 3 Deliverables:

- 1. 30% complete submittal package.
- 2. 60% complete submittal package.
- 3. 90% complete submittal package.
- 4. 100% complete submittal package.

Task 4 – Permitting of Force Main Designs

4.1 CONSULTANT shall prepare permit applications for construction of the force mains extensions to the following agencies:

- Palm Beach County Health Department (PBCHD)
- Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Utility Permit
- Palm Beach County Land Development Division Right-of-Way Permit
- 4.2 Engineer will coordinate with the permitting agencies during the review process on a regular basis in an effort to keep the project on schedule and respond to their review comments.
- 4.3 Permit fees will be paid by PBCWUD. CONSULTANT will respond to requests for information (RFIs) from the permitting agencies.

Task 5 - Project Management

Project management includes Consultant Services Authorization administration, QA/QC, and project meetings with COUNTY staff.

- 5.1 <u>Consultant Services Authorization Administration:</u> The progress of the project will be monitored and resources will be managed to achieve the schedule, budget, and work quality goals of the project. The CONSULTANT will keep the COUNTY informed as to the status and progress of the project. Communications with the COUNTY will be conducted under this Task.
- 5.2 <u>QA/QC</u>: The CONSULTANT will be conducting internal QA/QC review of the deliverables for conformance to Contract requirements and internal program requirements. The results of these reviews will be incorporated into the deliverables prior to submission to the COUNTY for review and comment.
- 5.3 <u>Project Meetings and Site Visits:</u> Attend and participate in project meetings with COUNTY staff. Attend three (3) meetings and 2 site visits total during the design phase of the project.

COMPENSATION

The CONSULTANT will be compensated in accordance with the attached budget summary (Attachment B), a lump sum amount of \$118,329.42. Monthly progress payments will be authorized based on percent complete as determined by CONSULTANT and approved by the COUNTY.

SBE PARTICIPATION

1. SCHEDULE 3(A) - Professional Services Activity Report

This form shall be submitted by the prime contractor with each payment application when SBE and/or M/WBE sub-consultants are utilized in the performance of the contract. This form shall contain the names of all SBE and M/WBE sub-consultants, specify the sub-consultants dollar amount for each sub-consultants and show amount drawn and payments to date issued to sub-consultants.

2. SCHEDULE 4 - SBE-M/WBE Payment Certification

A schedule 4 for each SBE and/or M/WBE sub-consultant shall be completed and signed by the proposed SBE and/or M/WBE after receipt of payment from the prime. When applicable, the prime shall submit this form with each application submitted to the

county for payment to document payment issued to a sub-consultant in the performance of the contract.

SBE participation is included in the **ATTACHMENT** F under this authorization. The attached Schedule 1 defines the SBE applied to this CSA/Contract and Schedule 2 establishes the SBE contribution from each subcontractor (Letter of Intend to perform as an SBE).
