I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a "Utility Design by FDOT Consultant Agreement" with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) in the amount of \$58,077.17.

Summary: FDOT is proposing improvements to State Road 80 (Southern Boulevard) at Lyons Road/Sansbury's Way. These improvements will necessitate the relocation of the existing 16" water main attached to the west side of the bridge located on Lyons Road over C-51 Canal, the existing 30" force main attached to the east side of the same bridge and the existing 4" force main located on the west side of Sansbury's Way. In order to have the FDOT consultant design the relocation of the water and sewer mains and make the relocation part of the road improvement project, FDOT requires the Water Utilities Department (WUD) to enter into a "Utility Design by FDOT Consultant Agreement" to reimburse FDOT for the work in the amount of \$58,077.17. (WUD Project No.16-028) Districts 2 and 6 (MJ)

Background and Justification: WUD has reviewed the proposed scope of services submitted by Stanley Consultants, Inc., the FDOT Consultant along with the preliminary roadway plans for the proposed improvements to State Road 80 (Southern Boulevard) at Lyons Road/Sansbury's Way and determined that the facilities will indeed be impacted and require relocation. Moreover, FDOT policy requires prepayment of the reimbursement amount of \$58,077.17, which WUD believes is necessary to conduct business with FDOT. Such prepayment is in compliance with Section 305.02 of the County Administrative Code.



WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the **FDOT**, is constructing, reconstructing, or ot herwise changing a portion of a public road or publicly owned rail corridor, said project being identified as <u>Southern Blvd at Sansbury Way/Lyon Road</u>, State Road No.: <u>80</u>, hereinafter referred to as the "Project"; and

WHEREAS, the UAO owns or desires to install certain utility facilities which are located within the limits of the Project hereinafter referred to as the "Facilities" (said term shall be deemed to include utilit@ccilities as the same may be relocated, adjusted, installed, or placed out of service pursuant to this Agreement); and

WHEREAS, the Project requires the location (vertically and/orhorizontally), protection, relocation, installation, adjustment or removal of the Facilities, or some combination thereof, hereinafter referred to as "Utility Work"; and

WHEREAS, the DEPARTMENT and the UTILITY have determined that it would be to the best interest of the general public and to the economic advantage of both parties tenter into an agreement providing for the design of the Utility Work by the engineer designing the Project for the FDOT, hereinafter referred to as the "FDOT Consultant," which design of the Utility Work shall hereinafter be referred to as the "Utility Design"; and

WHEREAS, the **UAO**, pursuant to the terms and conditions hereof, will bear certain costs associated with the Utility Design;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants contained herein, the FDOT and the UAO hereby agree as follows:

1. Design of Utility Work

- a. **FDOT Consultant** shall prepare, at the **UAO's** sole cost and expense, final engineering design, plans, other necessary related design documents, and cost estimate for the UtilityWork (hereinafter referred to as the "Plans Package") more specifically described in the **FDOT's** Supplemental Agreement #_1 to Consultant C9I74 Design Services Contract.
- b. The Plans Package shall be in the same format as the FDOT's contract documents for the Project.
- c. The Plans Package shall include any and all activities and work effort required to perform the Utility Work, including but not limited to, all clearing and grubbing, survey work and shall include a traffic control plan.
- d. The Plans Package shall be prepared in compliance with the FDOT's Utility Accommodation Manual and the FDOT's Plans Preparation Manual in effect at the time the Plans Package is prepared, and the FDOT's contract documents for the Project. If the FDOT's Plans Preparation Manual is updated and conflicts with the FDOT's Utility Accommodation Manual, the Utility Accommodation Manual shall apply where such conflicts exist.
- e. The technical special provisions which are a part of the Plans Package shall be prepared in

accordance with the FDOT's guidelines on preparation of technical special provisions.

- f. The FDOT Consultant shall provide a copy of the proposed Plans Package to the UAO, for review at the following stages: initial, constructability and biddability. The UAO shall review the Plans Package to see that it complies with the requirements of this Agreement.
- In the event the UAO finds any deficiencies in the Plans Package during the reviews performed g. pursuant to Subparagraph f. above, the UAO will notify the FDOT in writing of the deficiencies within the time specified in the plans review transmittal.
- The UAO shall furnish the FDOT such information from the UAO files as requested by the FDOT. h.
- i. The Facilities and the Utility Design will include all utility facilities of the UAO which are located within the limits of the Project, except as generally summarized as follows: _____. These exceptions shall be handled by separate arrangement.

2. Cost of Design

- The UAO shall be responsible for all costs of the Utility Design.
- b. The **UAO** agrees that it will, at least thirty (30) days prior to the **FDOT** issuing the Supplemental Agreement referred to in Paragraph 1 hereof, furnish the FDOT an advance deposit of \$58,077.17 for the payment of said Utility Design. It is understood that the FDOT's Consultant shall not begin any Utility Design until the FDOT has received the above payment and that if such payment is not received on or before 05/31/16 this Agreement shall be null and void. TenFDOT shall utilize this deposit for the payment of Utility Design. Both parties further agree that in the event the final billing pursuantto the terms of Subparagraph 2. d. below is less than the advance deposit, a refund of any excess will be made by the FDOT to the UAO. No work in excess of the advance deposit shall be done. In elevent that it is subsequently determined that work in addition to that described in the Supplemental Agreement described in Paragraph 1 hereof is necessary in order to properly complete the Utility Design, the UAO shall make an additional deposit in the amount necessary to issue a subsequent Supplemental Agreement to the FDOT Consultant for the additional work.

		as provided in the attached Three Party Escrow Agreement between the UAO , the FDOT and the State of Florida, Department of FinancialServices, Division of Treasury. Deposits of less than \$100,000.00 must be pre-approved by the Department of Financial Services and the FDOT Comptroller's Office prior to execution of this agreement.						

d. Upon final payment to the FDOT Consultant, the FDOT intends to have its final and complete accounting of all costs incurred in connection with the Utility Design within three hundred sixty (360) days. All project cost records and accounts shall be subject to audit by a representative of the UAO for a period of three (3) years after finalclose out of the project. The UAO will be notified of the final cost. Both parties agree that in the event the final accouning of total project costs pursuant to the terms of this agreement is less than the total deposits todate, a refund of the excess wilbe made by the FDOT to the UAO in accordance with Section 215.422, Florida Statutes.

Default

C.

In the event the UAO breaches any provision of this Agreement, then in addition to any other remedies a. which are otherwise provided for in this Agreement, the FDOT may exercise one or more of the following options, provided that at no time shall the FDOT be entitled to receive double recovery of damages:

- (1) Terminate this Agreement if the breach is material and has not been cured within 60 days from written notice thereof from the **FDOT.**
- (2) Pursue a claim for damages suffered by the **FDOT**.
- (3) Suspend the issuance of further permits to the **UAO** for the placement of Facilities on **FDOT** property if the breach is material and has not been cured within 60 days from written notice thereof from the **FDOT** until such time as the breach is cured.
- (4) Pursue any other remedies legally available.
- (5) Perform any work with its own forces or throughcontractors and seek repayment for the cost thereof under Section 337.403(3), Florida Statutes.
- b. In the event the **FDOT** breaches any provision of this Agreement, then in addition to any other remedies which are otherwise provided for in the Agreement, the **UAO** may exercise one or more of the following options:
 - (1) Terminate this Agreement if the breach is material and has not been cured within 60 days from written notice thereof from the UAO.
 - (2) Pursue any other remedies legally available.
- c. Termination of this Agreement shall not relieve either party from any obligations it has pursuant to other agreements between the parties or fom any statutory obligations that either party may have with regard to the subject matter hereof.

4. Indemnification

FOR GOVERNMENT-OWNED UTILITIES,

To the extent provided by law, the **UAO** shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the **FDOT** and all of its officers, agents, and employees from any claim, loss, damage, cost, charge, or expense arising out of anyacts, action, error, neglect, or omission by the **UAO**, its agents, employees, or contractors during the performance of the Agreement, whether direct or indirect, and whether to any person or property to which **FDOT** or said parties may be subject, except that neither the **UAO**, its agents, employees, or contractors will be liable under this section for damages arising out of the injury or damage topersons or property directly caused by or resulting from the negligence of the **FDOT** or any of its officers, agents, or employees during the performance of this Agreement.

When the FDOT receives a notice of claim for damages that may have been caused by the performance of services required under this Agreement, the FDOT will immediately forward the claim to the UAO. The UAO and the FDOT will evaluate the claim and report their findings to each other within fourteen (14) working days and will jointly discuss options in defending the claim. After reviewing the claim, the FDOT will determine whether to require the participation of the UAO in the defense of the claim or to require the UAO to defend the FDOT in such claim as described in this section. The DOT's failure to notify the UAO of a claim shall not release the UAO from any of the requirements of this section. The FDOT and the UAO will pay their own costs for the evaluation, settlement negotiations, and trial, if any. However, if only one party participates in the defense of the claim at trial, that party is responsible for all costs.

FOR NON-GOVERNMENT-OWNED UTILITIES,

The **UAO** shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the **FDOT** and all of its officers, agents, and employees from any claim, loss, damage, cost, charge, or expense arising out of any acts, action, error, neglect, or omission by the **UAO**, its agents, employees, or contractors during the performance of the Agreement,

whether direct or indirect, and whether to any person or property to which **FDOT** or said parties may be subject, except that neither the **UAO**, its agents, employees, or contractors will be liable under this section for damages arising out of the injury or damage to persons or property directly caused by or resulting from the negligence of the **FDOT** or any of its officers, agents, or employees during the performance of this Agreement.

The UAO's obligation to indemnify, defend, and pay for the defense or at the DOT's option, to participate and associate with the FDOT in the defense and trial of any damage claim or suit and any related settlement negotiations, shall arise within fourteen (14) days of receipt by the UAO of the FDOT's notice of claim for indemnification to the UAO. The notice of claim for indemnification shall be served by certified mail. The UAO's obligation to defend and indemnify within fourteen (14) days of such notice shall not be excused because of the UAO's inability to evaluate liability or because the UAO evaluates liability and determines the UAO is not liable or determines the FDOT is solely negligent. Only a final adjudication or judgment finding the FDOT solely negligent shall excuse performance of this provision by the UAO. The UAO shall pay all costs and fees related to this obligation and its enforcement by the FDOT. The FDOT's delay in notifying the UAO of a claim shall not release UAO of the above duty to defend.

5. Force Majeure

Neither the **UAO** nor the **FDOT** shall be liable to the other for any failure to perform under this Agreement to the extent such performance is prevented by an act of G od, war, riots, natural catastrophe, or other event beyond the control of the non-performing party and which could not have been avoided or overcome by the exercise of due diligence; provided that the party claiming the excuse from performance has (a) promptly notified the other party of the occurrence and its estimated duration, (b) promptly remedied or mitigated the effect of the occurrence to the extent possible, and (c) resumed performance as soon as possible.

6. Miscellaneous

- a. Time is of the essence in the performance of all obligations under this Agreement.
- b. The **FDOT** may unilaterally cancel this Agreement for refusal by the **JAO** to allow public access to all documents, papers, letters, or other material subject to the provisions of Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, and made or received by the **UAO** in conjunction with this Agreement.
- c. This Agreement constitutes the complete and final expression of the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings, or negotiations with respect thereto, except that the parties understand and agree that the FDOT has manuals and written policies and procedures which maybe applicable at the time of the Project and the relocation of the Facilitis.
- d. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of he State of Florida. Any provision hereof found to be unlawful or unenforceable shall be severable and shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.
- e. All notices required pursuant to the terms hereof may be sent by first class United States Mail, facsimile transmission, hand delivery, or express mail and shall be deemed to have been received by the end of five business days from the proper sending thereof unless proof of prior actual receipt is provided. The **UAO** shall have a continuing obligation to notify each District of the **FDOT** of the appropriate persons for notices to be sent pursuant to this Agreement. Unless otherwise notified in writing, notices shall be sent to the following addresses:

During the performance of this contract, the ENGINEERING CONTRACTOR, for itself, its assignees and successors in interest (hereinafter referred to as the "ENGINEER"), agrees as follows:

- (1) Compliance with Regulations: The ENGINEER will comply with the Regulations of the DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION relative to nondiscrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (hereinafter referred to as the DEPARTMENT) (Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 21, hereinafter referred to as the "Regulations"), which are herein incorporated by reference and made a part of this contract.
- (2) **Nondiscrimination:** The **ENGINEER**, with regard to the work performed by it after award and prior to completion of the contract work, will not discriminate on the grund of race, color or nationalorigin in the selection and retention of subcontractors, including procurement of materials or leases of equipment. The **ENGINEER** will not participate either directly or indirectly in the discrimi nation prohibited by Section 21.5 of the Regulations, including employment practices when the contract covers a program set forth in Appendix A & B of the Regulations.
- (3) **Solicitations:** In all solicitations either by competitive bidding or negotiation made by the **ENGINEER** for work to be performed under a subcontract, including procurement of materials and leases of equipment, each potential subcontractor or supplier shall be notified by the **ENGINEER** of the contractor's obligations under this contract and the Regulations relative to nondiscrimination on the ground of race, color or national origin.
- (4) Information and Reports: The ENGINEER will provide all information and reports required by the Regulations, or orders and instructions issued pursuant thereto, and will permit access to its books, records, accounts, other sources of information, and its facilities as may be determined by the DEPARTMENT or the Federal Highway Administration to be pertinent to ascertain compliance with such Regulations, orders and instructions. Where any information required of the ENGINEER is in the exclusive possession of another who fails or refuses to furnish this information, the ENGINEER shall so certify to the DEPARTMENT or the Federal Highway Administration as appropriate, and shall set forth what efforts it has made to obtain the information.
- (5) **Sanctions for Noncompliance:** In the event of the **ENGINEER's** noncompliance with the nondiscrimination provisions of paragraphs (1) through (4), the **DEPARTMENT** shall impose such contract sanctions as it or the Federal Highway Administration may determine to be appropriate, including, but not limited to:
 - (a) withholding of payments to the **ENGINEER** under the contract until the **ENGINEER** complies; and/or
 - (b) cancellation, termination or suspension of the contract, in whole or in part.
- (6) Incorporation of Provisions: The ENGINEER will include the provisions of paragraph (1) through (6) in every subcontract, including procurement of materials and leases of equipment, unless exempt by the Regulations, order or instructions issued pursuant thereto. The ENGINEER will take such action with respect to any subcontract, procurement or lease as the DEPARTMENT or the Federal Highway Administration may direct as a means of enforcing such provisions including sanctions for noncompliance; provided, however, that in the event the ENGINEER becomes involved in, or is threatened with, litigation with a subcontractor, supplier or lessor as a result of such direction, the ENGINEER may request the State to enter into such litigation to protect the interests of the State, and, in addition, the ENGINEER may request the United States to enter into such litigation to protect the interests of the United States.

Amendment 1 – UWHC for Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department WM and FM Utilities FDOT Project (FM 435158-1) SR 80/Lyons Road/Sansbury's Way Intersection Improvements

PROJECT LIMITS AND DESCRIPTION

This project involves intersection improvements at SR 80 and Lyons Road/Sansbury's Way. The improvements include widening Lyons Road and Sansbury's Way as well as the existing Lyons Road Bridge over the C-51 Canal to facilitate the proposed intersection improvements.

This scope amendment includes efforts to relocate the existing Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) utilities located within the project limits to facilitate the proposed intersection improvements. The relocation of the PBCWUD utilities will include the 16" Watermain and 30" Forcemain that crosses over the SFWMD C-51 Canal attached to the bridge and other locations where the proposed roadway improvements require the PBCWUD utilities to be relocated. The utility relocation tasks included with this scope amendment are as follows:

DESIGN SERVICES

- Design relocation of the 16" watermain between approximate Station 27+60 and Station 30+00 attached to the west side of the Lyons Road Bridge over the C-51 Canal.
- Design relocation of the 30" forcemain between approximate Station 27+60 and Station 30+00 attached to the east side of the Lyons Road Bridge over the C-51 Canal.
- Design relocation of the 4" forcemain at Station 42+10 LT, 43+60 LT and 46+30 LT due to facilitate roadway and drainage improvements.
- Design relocation of the 30" forcemain or design of a special conflict structure at Station 26+55 RT to accommodate proposed drainage facilities.
- Prepare and submit a FDEP Permit for the Watermain. This task includes review and response to FDEP requests for additional information. The anticipated Permit Fee is \$650.00.
- Prepare and submit a FDEP Permit for the Forcemain. This task includes review and response to FDEP requests for additional information. The anticipated Permit Fee is \$250.00.
- Prepare and submit a SFWMD Permit Modification for the Watermain. This task includes review and response to SFWMD requests for additional information. The anticipated Permit Fee is \$300.00.
- Prepare and submit a SFWMD Permit Modification for the Forcemain. This task includes review and response to SFWMD requests for additional information. The anticipated Permit Fee is \$300.00.
