I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Authorization No. 12 for the 16-inch Reclaimed Water Main Extension at Emerald Dunes Golf Course (Project) with Centerline Utilities, Inc. (R2013-0551) in the amount of \$413,386.81.

Summary: On May 7, 2013, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Water Utilities Department (WUD) Pipeline Continuing Construction Contract with Centerline Utilities, Inc. Work Authorization No. 12 provides for the construction of reclaimed water system infrastructure. The Project will connect an existing 16-inch reclaimed water main along the Florida Turnpike easement in the Emerald Dunes Golf Course to an existing 16-inch reclaimed water main in Okeechobee Boulevard. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15% overall. The contract with Centerline Utilities, Inc. provides for SBE participation of 16.56%. Work Authorization No. 12 includes 73.73% overall participation. The cumulative SBE participation including this authorization is 17.17% overall. Centerline Utilities, Inc. is not a Palm Beach County company. The Project is included in the FY16 Capital Improvement Plan adopted by the BCC. (WUD Project No. 15-015) District 2 (MJ)

Background and Justification: Construction of the Project is necessary to complete the pipeline loop needed to serve the areas surrounding the Emerald Dunes Golf Course. WUD has committed to undertaking the required construction activity between the Fourth of July and Labor Day while the Emerald Dunes Golf Club is closed. Work Authorization No. 12 will provide for the construction of the referenced reclaimed water main, valves, and related appurtenances.

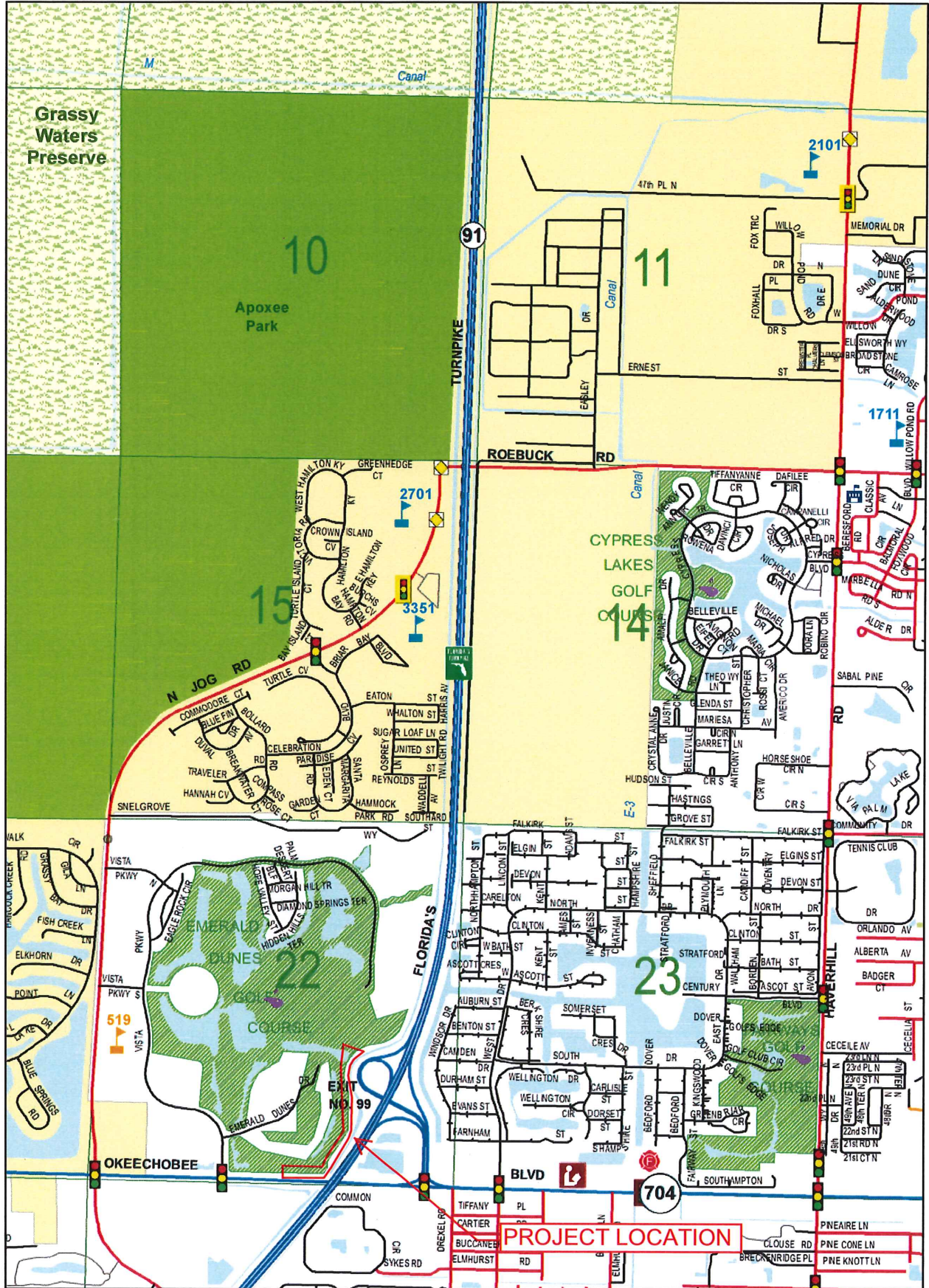

INTRODUCTION

Palm Beach County (County) entered into an agreement entitled Contract for Pipeline Continuing Construction Services - Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department Project No. WUD 15-015 (CONTRACT) with Centerline Utilities, Inc.
