RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR AND/OR HER DESIGNEES TO RESPOND WITH A LETTER OF NO OBJECTION TO MUNICIPALITIES WHEN THE COUNTY RECEIVES A MUNICIPAL NOTICE OF INTENT TO ESTABLISH A MUNICIPAL QUIET ZONE THAT WOULD INCLUDE A COUNTY MAINTAINED RAIL CROSSING.

WHEREAS, Various municipalities within Palm Beach County (County) have expressed a desire to create quiet zones along the Florida East Coast Railway due to the anticipated increase in the number of trains from the All Aboard Florida project; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Railroad Administration requires the public agency seeking to create a quiet zone send a Notice of Intent to the operating railroad, state agency responsible for highway and road safety and the state agency responsible for grade crossing safety; and

WHEREAS, the railroad and County have 60 days upon receipt of the Notice of Intent in which to provide comment to said Notice of Intent; and

WHEREAS, the County has been involved in the All Aboard Florida/Brightline project and supports municipalities' desire to establish quiet zones; and

WHEREAS, approval of this resolution will allow the County Administrator and/or her designees to respond to a Notice of Intent to create a quiet zone with a Letter of No Objection on behalf of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

The County Administrator and/or her designees are authorized to respond to a Notice of Intent to create a quiet zone with a Letter of No Objection on behalf of the County.

1. The recitations set forth above are true, accurate and correct and are incorporated herein.

2. This resolution will take effect upon its adoption.
