### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Contracts with Oglesby Construction, Inc. (Oglesby) and Southwide Industries, Inc. (Southwide), not to exceed a total value of \$1,520,000, for task orders which may be issued for the Annual Pavement Marking Contract (Contract), Project Number 2016051.

**SUMMARY:** Approval of these Contracts will provide for the furnishing and installation of pavement marking materials, raised reflectorized pavement markers and traffic paint on an as needed basis for various roadways throughout Palm Beach County. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for the project is 15%. Oglesby committed to 0% and Southwide committed to 100% SBE participation. Oglesby is not a Palm Beach County company. Southwide is a Palm Beach County based company.

#### Countywide (MRE)

**Background and Justification:** Bids were received by the Engineering Department on January 26, 2016. Oglesby was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. The second lowest responsive, responsible bidder was Southwide. The Office of Small Business Assistance issued its compliance review on March 7, 2016. These Contracts are for 18 months, with the possibility of extensions for up to a total of 36 months, with approval of the Board of County Commissioners. Oglesby and Southwide have agreed to hold their bid prices for 150 days after bid opening to allow adequate time to award this contract.
