
I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Contract with Electron Corp. of South Florida for the WTP No. 9 Wellfield Control Panel and RTU Improvements Project (Project) in the amount of \$1,165,468.

Summary: On May 4, 2016, three (3) bids were received to install variable frequency drives (VFDs) and remote telemetry units (RTUs) for nine (9) production wells along the Hillsboro Canal. Electron Corp. of South Florida was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the amount of \$1,165,468. Converting pumps from constant speed to a variable speed will optimize pumping and reduce energy usage. The RTU improvements will provide enhanced monitoring of the wells for the Water Utilities Department’s smart wellfield program. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15% overall. The Contract provides for SBE participation of 90% overall. Electron Corp. of South Florida is a Palm Beach County company. (WUD Project No. 14-098) District 5 (MJ)

Background and Justification: The Project will reduce the levels of energy consumption of the well pumps and motors at the WPT No. 9 wellfield. The VFDs and RTUs will help optimize the wells through the development of a smart wellfield. The Bid Review Comments for the three (3) lowest proposals is detailed in Attachment 5. The irregularities provided no competitive advantage.

The bid opening for the above referenced project was held on Wednesday, May 4, 2016. Proposals were received from three (3) contractors. The complete Bid Tabulation is attached. The engineer's opinion of probable construction cost was \$1,200,000 for Bid Item Numbers 1 through 26. An evaluation of the low and second low bid is as follows:

1. The first low bidder, Electron Corp. of South Florida, provided properly executed Bid Forms in the Contract Documents, subject to Item 6, below. The second low bidder, Current Connections, Inc., provided properly executed Bid Forms in the Contract Documents.
2. Bid security equal to 5% of the total base bid was enclosed with the bid for the first and second low bidders.
3. The first and second low bidders hold valid state contractor licenses. A copy of the license information for Electron Corp. of South Florida is included.
4. The first and second low bidders, Electron Corp. of South Florida, and Current Connections, Inc. are local businesses. They both have Local Preference and both have submitted the required documentation. (see attached Palm Beach County Tax Collector receipts).
5. SBE-MWBE Schedules #1 and #2 were provided. The first low and second low bidders have met the 15% SBE goal established under the SBE Ordinance. The first low bidder, Electron Corp. of South Florida, is SBE certified and has met the SBE goal for this project. The second low bidder, Current Connections, Inc., has met the SBE requirement for this project. The SBE compliance review is attached.
6. The bid tabulation for Electron Corp. of South Florida showed a mathematical error in the bid tabulation (Bid Item 15 and the Bid Total). This error increased the total base bid by \$567. The corrected total base bid amount is \$1,165,468.
7. The County Attorney (CAO) has reviewed the bid and Bid Review Comments for the apparent low bidder. No major irregularities were identified for Electron Corp. of South Florida; see attached email correspondence. The Water Utilities Department will waive the minor irregularities.

As a result of this evaluation we recommend Electron Corp. of South Florida as the successful, responsive, low bidder. Contract award is recommended to the lowest responsive bidder in the amount not to exceed \$1,165,468.00 subject to formal approval by the Board of County Commissioners. A copy of this notice has been emailed to all bidders and is posted at the bid opening location and will be left there for a minimum of five (5) business days.

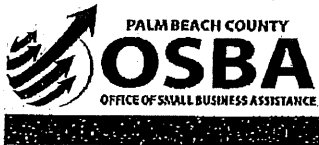

See my comments below related to the irregularities identified on the Bid Review Comments document:

Electron Corporation of South Florida

1. Errors in bid tabulation (Item 15 and Bid Total). This increased the total base bid by \$567. The corrected total base bid amount is \$1,165,468.

Response: Corrected in accordance with Section 5.1.3 of the ITB; not an irregularity.

2. Subcontractor (GAP Design, LLC) has an active certification with Palm Beach County; however, Workers Comp expired on 1-30-16. Following the bid opening, Gap Design, LLC has provided a 'Certificate of Election to be Exempt from Florida Workers' Compensation Law'.

Response: Insurance requirements are not required to be met at the time of bidding, but instead prior to the execution of the contract per Section 5.2.5 of the ITB, so this is not an irregularity. I am not familiar with the waiver provisions of WC, so please check with Scott Marting to determine if this sub can waive. Let me know if you need me to look into further.

Current Connections, Inc.

1. Subcontractor (Overland Construction Co, Inc.) has an active certification with Palm Beach County; however, Insurance and Workers Comp expired on 3-1-16.

Response: Insurance requirements are not required to be met at the time of bidding, but instead prior to the execution of the contract per Section 5.2.5 of the ITB, so this is not an irregularity.

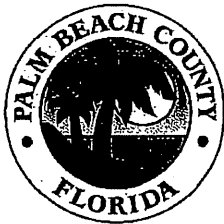
