I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Contract with Rangeline Tapping Services, Inc. for the Water Utilities Department Pipe Wet Tapping & Line Stopping Continuing Contract to provide materials and installation services over a two (2) year term with the option of two (2) one (1) year renewals in an amount not to exceed \$4,763,649.10.

Summary: On March 16, 2016, one (1) bid was received for the Water Utilities Department (WUD) Pipe Wet Tapping & Line Stops Continuing Contract. Rangeline Tapping Services, Inc. is the lowest, responsible and responsive bidder. The Contract will be used to expedite the installation of pipe wet taps and line stops for emergency pipe repairs, pipe and valve replacements and construction projects throughout the WUD service area. The Contract is for the total bid prices, and does not guarantee or authorize Rangeline Tapping Services, Inc. to perform any work. Work will be assigned during the two (2) year Contract period by formal work authorizations drawn against this Contract, with approvals pursuant to PPM CW-F-050. The unit prices for labor and materials contained in this Contract will be used in determining the cost of work authorizations. Supplements to work authorizations for changes that occur during construction will be subject to the change order limits for construction contracts as established under PPM CW-F-050 with each work authorization considered as an individual construction contract. There shall be no increase in the Contract unit prices for the duration of the Contract or any renewal terms. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15% overall. The Contract with Rangeline Tapping Services, Inc. provides for SBE participation of 100% overall. Rangeline Tapping Services, Inc. is a Palm Beach County company. (WUD Project No. 16-022) District 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6 (MJ)

Background and Justification: WUD performs maintenance, repair and construction activities on water, wastewater and reclaim water pipelines throughout its service area. This continuing construction contract will reduce the time needed for specialized installation of pipe wet tapping and line stop services needed to complete the utility repairs and improvements. Pipe wet tapping and line stops allow connection to, or shutdown of flow in a piping system without taking the piping system out of service. This increases reliability and reduces the time for necessary and/or emergency repairs. The engineer's opinion of probable construction cost was \$4 million. WUD staff evaluated the low bid and recommended award of the Contract to Rangeline Tapping Services, Inc., as the successful low bidder. The errors, omissions or irregularities in the bid were determined to be minor and did not impact the substance of the bid.



The bid opening for the above referenced project was held on Wednesday, March 16, 2016. Proposals were received from one (1) contractor. The complete Bid Tabulation is attached. The engineer's opinion of probable construction cost was \$4,000,000.00 for Bid Item Numbers 1 through 246. An evaluation of the low bid is as follows:

- 1. The Bid Form provided in the Contract Documents was properly executed.
- 2. Bid security equal to 5% of the total base bid was enclosed with the bid.
- 3. The contractor holds a valid state contractor's license. A copy of the license information is included.
- 4. Rangeline Tapping Services, Inc. has Local Preference and has submitted the required documentation. (see attached Palm Beach County Tax Collector receipt).
- 5. SBE-M/WBE Schedules #1 and #2 were provided. The low bid submitted has met the 15% SBE goal established under the SBE Ordinance, (see attached SBE-M/WBE compliance review stating Rangeline Tapping Services has 100% SBE participation).
- The County Attorney reviewed the bid and Bid Review Comments for Rangeline Tapping Services, Inc. and determined that Rangeline Tapping Services, Inc. does not have any bid irregularities and the bid is responsive.

As a result of this evaluation, we recommend Rangeline Tapping Services, Inc. as the successful, responsive, low bidder. Contract award is recommended to the lowest responsive bidder in the amount not to exceed \$4,763,648.80 subject to formal approval by the Board of County Commissioners. A copy of this notice has been emailed to all bidders and is posted at the bid opening location and will be left there for a minimum of five (5) business days.


