#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

### Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to:

- A) Adopt a resolution confirming the special assessment process for paving and drainage improvements of Penny Lane, Melaleuca Lane to the dead end (Project);
- Approve a budget transfer from the Office of Community Revitalization (OCR) in the amount of \$360,000 (\$100,000 from CCRT Recoup Funding; \$100,000 from Neighborhood Partnership Grant Program; and \$160,000 from Home Beautification Improvement Grant) and appropriate it to the Project; and
- C) Approve a budget transfer from the Unincorporated Improvement Fund Reserves in the amount of \$32,500 and appropriate it to the Project.

SUMMARY: Adoption of the resolution will allow Palm Beach County (County) to assess a fixed amount of \$25 per abutting footage to all 16 benefitting property owners along the Project. Assessments will be payable in 10 equal annual installments at an interest rate of five and one half percent (5.5%) per annum and the assessment averages about \$2,000 per property. The Project includes construction of roadway pavement, driveway reconstruction and installation of a new stormwater system.

#### District 3 (MRE)

**Background and Justification:** At the April 16, 2013 Board of County Commissioners (Board) meeting, the Board approved a request from OCR for funds totaling \$180,900 from the Countywide Community Revitalization Team (CCRT) reserve funding account, an allocation of \$32,500 from the MSTU account, and a capped assessment of \$25 per abutting footage for benefitting properties along the Project. An additional estimated amount of \$360,000 is required from the OCR to complete the Project.

In accordance with Section 26-30.3 of the MSTU Code, the Engineering Department advertised the Project for this public hearing on Sunday, June 19, 2016 and Sunday, June 26, 2016. A comprehensive explanation of the proposed improvements were distributed by regular mail to the property owners to be assessed in lieu of a public information meeting, as allowed for in Section 26-30.2 of the MSTU Code.

Adoption of the resolution will allow assessment for paving and drainage improvements of the Project.

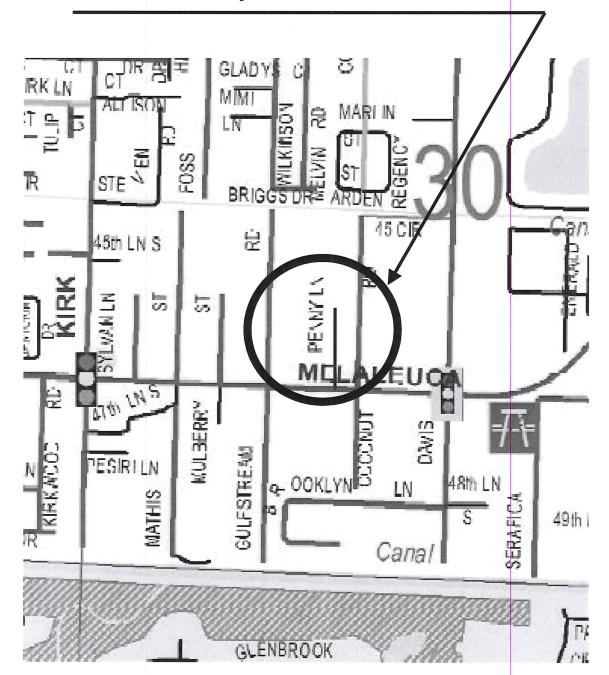

#### **RESOLUTION NO. R-2016-**

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA CONFIRMING THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT PROCESS FOR PAVING AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS OF PENNY LANE, MELALEUCA LANE TO THE DEAD END, SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 44 SOUTH, RANGE 43 EAST, PURSUANT TO A PUBLIC HEARING HELD THEREON.

WHEREAS, a special assessment process was initiated for the paving and drainage improvement of Penny Lane, Melaleuca Lane to the dead end (Project) located within a Countywide Community Revitalization Team (CCRT) area, authorized pursuant to Palm Beach County Code Chapter 26, Article II, Division 1, known as the Municipal Service Taxing Unit (MSTU) Special Assessment Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, paving and drainage Projects located within CCRT areas are capped at \$25 per abutting footage for benefitting property owners; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) authorized the assessment of \$25 per abutting footage to the benefitting property owners, and allocated an amount not to exceed \$32,500 from the MSTU for the Project at the April 16, 2013 Board meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Community Redevelopment (OCR) will provide \$540,900 toward the cost of the Project. The total cost of the Project is currently estimated at \$573,400; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 26-30.3, the Board did hold a public hearing on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2016, at the Commission Chambers of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, so as to satisfy the requirements of the MSTU Special Assessment Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the public notice and public hearing requirements of the MSTU Special Assessment Ordinance have been met.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

The Report of Costs and the Special Assessment Roll for the paving and drainage improvement of Penny Lane, Melaleuca Lane to dead end, Section 30, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, is on file in the office of the Clerk and Comptroller of the County and attached hereto as EXHIBIT I and EXHIBIT II respectively, and such assessment shall stand affirmed and remain legal, valid and binding as a first lien upon the property

against which such assessment is made until paid. Promptly after such confirmation of assessment, the assessment roll shall be recorded in the official records of the Clerk and Comptroller of the County to facilitate knowledge of the lien by third parties.

- 1. The said special assessments are hereby made upon all parcels of land described in said Special Assessment Roll (EXHIBIT II) in the amount shown thereon.
- 2. Pursuant to the MSTU Special Assessment Ordinance, the following Project is hereby approved: Paving and Drainage Improvement of Penny Lane, Melaleuca Lane to dead end, Section 30, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, Palm Beach County, Florida.
- 3. Pursuant to the MSTU Special Assessment Ordinance, any and all special assessments made pursuant to this Resolution, which have not been paid in full within thirty (30) days after notice of completion of the subject improvements for which said assessment was made, shall be subject to interest at a rate of five and one half percent (5.5%) per annum from the date of the acceptance of said improvement by Palm Beach County and shall be payable in ten (10) equal annual installments.
- 4. A special assessment in the fixed amount of \$25 per abutting footage shall be collected toward the costs of the Project. The total cost of the Project funded through the MSTU is estimated at \$32,500.
- 5. The Board finds that each parcel listed on EXHIBIT II will obtain a special benefit which is at least equal to the amount of special assessment made against each such parcel.
- 6. Pursuant to Section 26-30.6 of the MSTU Special Assessment Ordinance, if any special assessment made under this resolution shall be either in whole or part vacated or set aside by the judgment of any court; or if the Board shall be satisfied that such assessment is so irregular or defective that the same cannot be enforced or collected; or if the Board omitted to make any such assessment when it might have done so, the Board shall take all necessary steps to cause a new assessment to be made for any improvement and against any property specially benefitted by such improvement.
