Summary: The Youth Violence Prevention agencies funded under the Community Service Department's Financially Assisted Agency (FAA) program were transferred to the Youth Services Department in 2015 and are now referred to as Community Based Agencies (CBA). These Agencies offer a variety of services to youth to enhance leadership skills and prevent interaction or further interaction with the juvenile justice system. Each Contract includes two (2), one (1) year extension options, at the County's sole discretion. These Contract totals were approved during the FY17 budget process. Countywide (HH)

Background and Justification: These agencies were funded through the Community Services Department, under its Financially Assisted Agencies (FAA) program, prior to being seamlessly transferred to the Youth Services Department. Additional reporting requirements have been added to these contracts to allow for better evaluation of the program effectiveness and ensure fiscal accountability.
