I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Change Order No. 9 with MWH Constructors, Inc. for the Water Treatment Plant (WTP) No. 2 Filter Replacement (Project) with a 105-day time extension.

Summary: On February 4, 2014, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Contract for the WTP No. 2 Filter Replacement (R2014-0150) with MWH Constructors, Inc. Change Order No. 9 provides for additional days with no cost increases to allow for unanticipated needs that occurred during the start-up, testing and placing of several pieces of equipment into service due to system demands at WTP No. 2 and the necessary demolition of existing structures onsite. Additionally, the extension incorporates the additional time required for the Health Department to release the Project. MWH Constructors, Inc. is a Palm Beach County company. (WUD Project No. 12-066) (District 7) (MJ)

Background and Justification: Change Order No. 9 is necessary to allow for the continued authorization of work under the Project in response to delays encountered as equipment was placed and tested at WTP 2. The time extension additionally allows for the demolition of structures that are no longer required as a result of the Project and required inspections by the Department of Health.



Dear Mr. Riccobono:

We respectively request a Contract Time Adjustment of 105 calendar days for Substantial and Final Completion. This request is made pursuant to SECTION 01324A, Article 1.8, paragraph A.2, Excusable Delays.

Our efforts to achieve Substantial and Final completion were hindered due to operational considerations at WTP 2, specifically the lack of availability of an adequate water supply to perform filter backwashing and checkout, and due to the greater than anticipated time required to obtain partial system clearances from the health department.

Our revised request is predicated upon a longer than expected time to fully integrate operation of the new filter facility into WTP 2 operations.

We understand that this request is a significant increase, but believe that it:

- · Provides adequate time for PBCWUD to fully integrate the new filters into its operations; and
- Provides an appropriate time period to complete demolition and final construction activities.

Upon your favorable consideration of this request, the revised Substantial Completion Date would be October 12, 2016 and the Final Completion date would be December 11, 2016.
