Background And Justification (Continued):

Background And Justification: Section 320.03(6), Florida Statutes, was further amended to provide that an approved local air pollution control program is eligible to receive an additional twenty-five cents (25ϕ) from the fee for a total of seventy-five cents (75ϕ) , provided the local air pollution control trust fund has an unencumbered balance not exceeding 50% of the previous year's revenue allocation. It is estimated that the unencumbered balance at the end of the current fiscal year will be less than 50% of the annual revenue thus making the County eligible to continue receiving funding at the 75ϕ level. It is also estimated that annual tag fee revenues will be equivalent to the FY 2016/2017 budget request. Therefore, sufficient funds will be available for this budget.

RESOLUTION NO.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FY 2016/2017 BUDGET FOR THE AIR POLLUTION CONTROL PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, on August 21, 1984, the Board of County Commissioners entered into an agreement with the Department of Health Palm Beach County to continue an Air Pollution Control Program and establish an Air Pollution Control Trust Fund pursuant to Sections 403.182 and 320.03(6), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement requires the Health Department to submit a budget to the County on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the projected budget for the expenditure of monies deposited into the Air Pollution Control Trust

Fund for FY 2016/2017 is as follows:
