I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: a resolution to support the improvements planned for the Palmetto Park Road shared use pathway from US441 (SR7) to SW 3rd Avenue (Project) by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).



SUMMARY: Adoption of this resolution will support the planned improvements by FDOT to the Project. The existing pathway, including width and alignment, will be upgraded to comply with standards for a shared use pathway (typically 10') and to comply with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Palm Beach County (County) has jurisdiction over, and maintenance responsibility for, Palmetto Park Road and the adjacent shared use pathway within the County's right-of-way from US441 (SR7) to SW 3rd Avenue. FDOT's policy requires all local agencies that have jurisdiction or facilities impacted by planned FDOT improvements to adopt a resolution supporting the planned improvements.

Districts 4 and 5 (MRE)

Background and Justification: The existing pathway is in a state of deterioration and many sections, including the width and alignment, do not comply with the standards for a shared use pathway or with ADA standards. This Project is on the County Metropolitan Planning Organization list and federal funds have been allocated for it. It is the intent of the County to take over the maintenance of the Palmetto Park Road shared use pathway from US441 (SR7) to SW 3rd Avenue upon completion of the improvements by FDOT. The County's Engineering Department recommends the adoption of the resolution.



RESOLUTION NO. R-2016-

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE PALMETTO PARK ROAD SHARED USE PATHWAY FROM US441 (SR7) TO SW 3RD AVENUE BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to reconstruct the Palmetto Park Road shared use pathway, from US441 (SR7) to SW 3rd Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the condition of the existing path is in a state of deterioration and many sections do not comply with standards for a shared use path including its width, alignment, and compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards; and

WHEREAS, FDOT is currently working on the design of the pathway improvements on Palmetto Park Road from US441 (SR7) to SW 3rd Avenue, an off-system facility, under Financial Project ID 435160-1; and

WHEREAS, the design and construction costs will be funded and administered through the FDOT; and

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County (County) has jurisdiction over, and maintenance responsibility for, Palmetto Park Road and the adjacent shared use pathway facilities within the County right-of-way from US441 (SR7) to SW 3rd Avenue; and

WHEREAS, FDOT has requested that the County adopt a resolution to endorse and memorialize the County's support for the planned improvements; and

WHEREAS, the planned improvements will greatly benefit the residents and traveling public in southern Palm Beach County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

1. The recitations set forth herein above are true, accurate and correct and are incorporated herein.
2. The County supports FDOT's plans to improve the Palmetto Park Road shared use pathway from US441 (SR7) to SW 3rd Avenue.
3. It is the intent of the County to take over the maintenance of the Palmetto Park Road shared use pathway from US441 (SR7) to SW 3rd Avenue upon completion of the improvements by FDOT.
4. This resolution will take effect upon its adoption.
