### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file:** Project Agreement Amendment to Project Agreement PB-14-183 (R2014-1940), Torry Island Reef Project with the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND), extends the project completion term one year from September 30, 2016 to September 30, 2017.

**Summary:** On December 16, 2014, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved Project Agreement PB-14-183 with FIND for the Torry Island Reef Project providing 50% funding assistance and a completion date of September 30, 2016. The Project Agreement Amendment was necessary due to a permitting delay by the United States Army Corps of Engineers requiring relocation of the original reef site. On May 6, 2014, the BCC adopted a Resolution for Assistance (R2014-0616) and provided a Delegation of Authority to sign all future time extensions, certifications, and other forms associated with this Agreement and necessary minor amendments that do not change the scope of work or terms and conditions of this Agreement. **Background and Justification:** On May 6, 2014, the BCC adopted a Resolution for Assistance (R2014-0616) with the FIND Waterways Assistance Program authorizing the submission of a grant application for the Torry Island Reef Project. On December 16, 2014, the BCC approved the Torry Island Reef Project Agreement PB14-183 with a completion date of September 30, 2016.
