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I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- (A) A contract with A1 Property Services Group, Inc. in the amount of \$757,867 for Building 3400 Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning (HVAC) and Roof Improvements at Palm Beach International Airport (PBIA); and
- **(B)**A Budget Transfer of \$757,867 in the Airport's Improvement and Development Fund to provide for the A1 Property Services Group, Inc. contract. This includes a transfer from Reserves of \$757,867.

Summary: This project was advertised utilizing the County's competitive bid process. On July 28, 2016, three (3) bids were received for Building 3400 HVAC and Roof Improvements at PBIA. Of the three (3) bids, A1 Property Services Group, Inc. a Miami Dade County company has been identified as the lowest responsible/responsive bidder in the amount of \$757,867. The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Goal for this project was established at 11%. A1 Property Services Group, Inc. has committed to a minimum of 11% DBE participation. Local Funds are being utilized to fund this project. **Countywide (AH)**

Background and Justification: This project consists of the replacement of the existing roofing, roof insulation, metal flashing, two new roof-top HVAC units, and associated electrical improvements for Building 3400 at PBIA. These improvements are necessary due to the age of the existing systems and facilities. Building 3400 is leased to CareerSource Palm Beach County, Inc. (R-2013-0534). Under the terms of the lease, the County is responsible for maintenance and repair of the roof, HVAC system and structural repairs to the exterior of the building. Builder's Risk Insurance will be provided by the contractor.



A total of three (3) bids were received. The Bids received were from Advanced Roofing, Inc., A1 Property Services Group, Inc., and DeckTight Roofing Services, Inc. The base bids are arranged from lowest to highest along with the Engineer's Estimate in Table 1 below.

AECOM's review of the bids indicated that two (2) bidders have provided all supporting documentation required per the bid documents. One Bidder, A1 Property Services, Inc., did not submit the Acknowledgement of Receipt pages from the 4 addenda issued during the Bid, but did acknowledge receipt of addenda in the bid form.

AECOM's review of the bid calculations indicated that all bids were accurately submitted. The Bid Tabulation analysis and the Bid Review Checklist are attached.

Based on the qualifications of the three (3) bids submitted, all bidders show experience as a prime contractors for similar roofing projects with DeckTight Roofing Services, Inc., having performed work at Palm Beach International Airport (PBI) in the past ten (10) years.

Based on AECOM's evaluation of the base bid; qualifications, experience and the bids obtained, it is our recommendation that the DOA award the PB 16-3, Building 3400 HVAC and Roof Improvements contract to the lowest responsible/responsive bidder, Advanced Roofing, Inc., contingent on the DOA's legal and DBE review of the bid documents.
