### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to:** Conceptually Approve for J&R Care Finders, Inc. (Company) **A)** A Section 108 Loan with in the amount of \$42,836, contingent upon approval of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and **B)** a USDA Intermediary Relending Program (IRP) loan in the amount of \$53,545.00, contingent upon approval of the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

Summary: The Company, founded in 2010 provides home health care and related services to elderly clients or medically compromised individuals. The Company currently rents space in Boca Raton, but with a large client base in the western portion of the County, the Company has signed a long term lease at 323 Bacom Point Road, Pahokee, FL, which is in Census Tract 80.02, and has a poverty rate of 39.8%. The total project cost is \$107,090 and the applicant has committed 10% of the total project cost in the amount of \$10,709. This project is located in an economically distressed area and supports a Minority Women owned Business Enterprise (MWBE). Program funds in the amount of \$96,381 are being recommended to be allocated to the Company. The funds will provide working capital, allowing the principal to expand the business. This project will meet HUD's national objective by creating 3 full-time jobs. The loan project was approved by The Loan Review Committee on September 29, 2016. Upon conceptual approval by the Board of County Commissioners, the loan package will then be submitted to HUD and USDA for approval and funding. District 7 (JB)

**Background:** The Palm Beach County Section 108 Loan Program (Program), which is administered by the Palm Beach County Department of Economic Sustainability, was developed to create a source of loan funding for use by businesses and investors to implement business ventures that will create new jobs to benefit low to moderate income communities, prevent or eliminate urban blight or meet a critical community need. Funding for the Program is received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The Palm Beach County USDA IRP Loan Program also administered by the Palm Beach County Department of Economic Sustainability, was developed to create a source of loan funding for use by businesses and investors in the rural designated areas of Palm Beach County. Conceptual approval of this project will provide a critical need for the community.
