#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:** Contract with Johnson-Davis Incorporated (Contract) for the 16" Water System Improvements on Lyons Road from the Lake Worth Drainage District (LWDD) L-5 Canal to North of Pioneer Road (Project) in the amount of \$543,110.

**Summary:** On August 31, 2016, three (3) bids were received to undertake the Project, which requires the construction of approximately 2,200 linear feet of 16" Ductile Iron Pipe (DIP) water main. The Project will improve system capacity and hydraulic efficiencies, eliminate dead ends, and decrease water retention time in the distribution system, which will result in improved water quality. Johnson-Davis Incorporated was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the amount of \$543,110. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15% overall. The Contract provides for SBE participation of 17.068% overall. Johnson-Davis Incorporated is a Palm Beach County company. The Project is included in the FY 17 Capital Improvement Plan adopted by the BCC. (WUD Project No. 16-061R) <u>Districts 2 and 6 (MJ)</u>

**Background and Justification:** The Water Utilities Department (WUD) owns, operates and maintains approximately 2,173 miles of water main pipe. WUD has implemented an Infrastructure Improvement Program for continuing and improving water service to the community. The Project will increase system capacity and reliability in the eastern portion of the WUD water distribution system.





The bid opening for the above referenced project was held on Wednesday, August 31, 2016. Proposals were received from three (3) contractors. The complete Bid Tabulation is attached. The Engineer's opinion of probable construction cost was \$550,000.00. The low bidder is Johnson-Davis, Inc. with a construction cost of \$543,110.00 for the bid.

An evaluation of the low bid by Johnson-Davis, Inc. is as follows:

- 1. The first low bidder, Johnson-Davis, Inc., provided properly executed Bid Forms in the Contract Documents.
- 2. Bid security equal to 5% of the total base bid was enclosed with the bid.
- 3. SBE-M/WBE Schedules #1 and #2 were properly filled out. Johnson-Davis, Inc. has met the 15% SBE goal established under the SBE Ordinance. The Compliance Review completed by the Office of Small Business Assistance states that Johnson-Davis, Inc. has met the SBE goal with 17.068% SBE participation for this project (See attached review letter from Patricia Wilhelm dated September 15, 2016.).
- 4. The County Attorney (CAO) has reviewed the bid and Bid Review Comments for the three (3) lowest bids. For Johnson-Davis, Inc., no major irregularities were identified. (See attached Bid Review Comments and email from CAO's Michael Jones dated September 20, 2016.).

- 5. There was one addendum issued for this project. Johnson-Davis, Inc. acknowledged the addendum.
- 6. Johnson-Davis, Inc. holds valid general contractor and occupational licenses. Johnson-Davis, Inc. had a valid Palm Beach County business tax receipt at the time of the bid submittal (See attached Palm Beach County Tax Collector receipt.).
- 7. The first low bidder, Johnson-Davis, Inc., holds a principal place of business in Palm Beach County. The contractor holds a valid state contractor's license (See attached license information.).

Contract award is recommended to the lowest responsive bidder, Johnson-Davis, Inc., in the amount not to exceed \$543,110.00 for the bid, subject to formal approval by the PBC Board of County Commissioners. A copy of this notice has been emailed to all bidders and posted at the bid opening location and will be left there for a minimum of five (5) business days.


