EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: an annual traffic loops contract, Project No. 2017050, with AUM Construction, Inc. (AUM), in an amount not to exceed the total value of \$1,000,000 for task orders.

SUMMARY: Approval of this contract will facilitate the furnishing and installation of traffic signal loops. The Palm Beach County Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for all contracts is 15%. The SBE participation committed for the project by AUM is 100%. AUM is a Palm Beach County based company. This contract is for 12 months, with the possibility of an extension for up to a total of 36 months. Countywide (JB)

Background and Justification: Bids for the project were received by the Engineering Department on November 29, 2016. AUM, the sole bidder, was found to be responsive and responsible. The above contract amount is based on the estimated amount to be expended for traffic loops throughout Palm Beach County over a 12 month period.

It is understood and agreed that the time limit for completion of said work is the essence of the contract and should the Contractor fail to complete the work within the time limit, it is agreed that for such calendar day that any work provided for in these Contract Documents shall remain incomplete after the time limit has expired, including any official extension of the time limit; the sum per day given in the contained schedules shall be deducted from monies due the Contractor, not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages and added expense for supervision.
