EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a contract with Ferreira Construction Southern Division Co., Inc. (Ferreira) in the amount of \$297,391 for the construction of Summit Boulevard over LWDD E-3 Canal.

SUMMARY: Approval of this contract will allow Palm Beach County to issue a notice to proceed to Ferreira, a New Jersey based company with an office in Stuart, Florida, to begin construction of the Summit Boulevard Bridge over LWDD E-3 Canal. The proposed work consists of restoring and stabilizing the embankment north of the Summit Boulevard Bridge over the LWDD E-3 Canal and bridge modifications to improve canal bank access. The Palm Beach County Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for all contracts is 15%. Ferreira, the sole responsive, responsible bidder proposed 2.1% SBE participation. District 2 (LDC)

Background and Justification: Bids for the Summit Boulevard Bridge over LWDD E-3 Canal were received by the Engineering Department on November 29, 2016. Ferreira was the sole responsive, responsible bidder. Time to complete all work under this contract shall be no more than 90 calendar days.



1	Item (1) - Permitting agency pre-construction meetings and notices of commencement; compliance with stormwater pollution prevention plan; installation of erosion/turbidity controls including sediment barriers, inlet protection, inspection and reporting; preparation and submittal of construction completion certifications and required record drawings by a professional engineer and/or land surveyor; utility notifications are considered incidental to mobilization.
2	Item (2) - Includes the cost of barricades, construction signs, flashing lights, arrow boards, temporary concrete barrier walls, sheeting, shoring, drop off protection, temporary asphalt pavement and any other miscellaneous devices required to conform to the F.D.O.T. Roadway and Traffic Design Standards (latest edition), and the traffic control notes included in these plans. Includes the cost of temporary pavement marking indicating lane lines and storage areas for turning movements throughout the project at the end of each day's operations. Includes cost of all variable message boards and traffic control devices as necessary. Includes cost for immediate removal of storm water from roadways.
