Background & Justification: The Resolution which provided authority for the County Administrator or her designee to execute standard license agreements was designed to expedite and streamline the process for commercial use of county owned property after submission of an application for use and after determination of whether a license fee should be charged for the use. There is no license fee if the applicant demonstrates that (i) the activity is for the purpose of promoting community interest and welfare and (ii) the applicant will not realize a profit based on the use.
