I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: Supplement No. 7 to Project Agreement R2002-0736 with URS Corporation Southern (URS), in the amount of \$79,796.66 for professional services for the Seminole Pratt Whitney Road from north of Orange Boulevard to south of Northlake Boulevard project.

SUMMARY: This supplement provides the services necessary for the preparation of revised plans for the project. This supplement was approved on January 27, 2016, by the Contract Review Committee (CRC). In accordance with PPM No. CW-F-050, approval of this supplement must be received and filed by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) since the cumulative value of additional services now exceeds \$250,000. At the time of this Project Agreement award, Palm Beach County's annual Minority/Women Business Enterprise's (MWBE) goal was 11.1% participation. URS committed to 35% at the time of consultant selection for the project, and they have committed to 10.98% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation for this supplement. To date, there is a total SBE/MWBE utilization of 27.91%. District 6 (MJ)

Background and Justification: On May 21, 2002, the BCC approved Project Agreement R2002-0736 with E.C. Driver & Associates, Inc. (ECD) to provide professional services required to prepare design plans and construction bid documents for the project. On August 13, 2013, the BCC approved Novation Agreement R2013-0995 between ECD and URS to transfer the agreement to URS. Palm Beach County then instructed URS to revise the plans to provide six (6) side street ingress/egress improvements at intersections within the project corridor, revise Pond #2 per Indian Trail Improvement District's request, perform additional topographic survey as required, plus process additional permitting for the project, as detailed in Exhibit "A" of the attached supplement which was approved by the CRC. In accordance with PPM No. CW-F-050, approval of this supplement must be received and filed by the BCC since the cumulative value of additional services now exceeds \$250,000.



Scope of Consultant Services <u>Supplemental Amendment No. 7</u> Seminole Pratt-Whitney Road from Orange Blvd. to south of Northlake Blvd. County Project No. 1997511D

URS Corporation Southern (URS) will perform additional services for the above referenced project as

- A. Design of six (6) side street ingress/egress improvements within the project corridor in order to satisfy Indian Trails Improvement District's (ITID) request for traffic calming improvements at the following intersections: 1. Valencia Blvd

 - 2. Citrus Grove Blvd
 - 3. Temple Blvd (2 Locations)
 - 4. Key Lime Blvd (2 Locations)

Specific details include:

- Revise plan geometrics for the above 6 locations in order to accommodate a revised side street ingress/egress configuration consisting a 12' curb and gutter median, one (1) 15' entry lane, one (1) 11' thru-left exit lane and one (1) 10' right turn lane, (see attachment B, 5 of 5). Valencia Blvd and Citrus Grove Blvd will only have the entry lane and outbound right-turn lane, due to the directional configuration of the median opening along Seminole Pratt Whitney Rd at each of these
- B. Redesign of Pond #2, per previous ITID request (see attached ITID site plan), in order to provide amenities similar to those at the lake on Coconut and 89th (Coconut Park).

Specific details include:

- Provide a 6' wide asphalt path around pond #2 at or near the top of the berm.
- Provide paved parking spaces, including 2 handicap accessible spaces). PBC provided pavement design will be used for parking area.
- Provide ADA access from the parking area to the path and from the sidewalk along Seminole Pratt Whitney Road to the path as well as compliance along the path.
- Installation of culverts connecting the SE and SW corners of pond #2 with the adjacent canal, along with the removal of control structure between pond #2 and the canal- The pond will essentially become part of the canal, with treatment for water quality achieved within the overall
- Pedestrian bridge $\underline{\textit{will not}}$ be proposed, as originally shown in the attached site plan.
- Chain link fence will not be shown around the pond, in order to allow access by residents.
- Quantities for the amenities will be tabulated separately from the quantities necessary for the

- C. Brown & Phillips, Inc., subconsultant to URS, will provide additional topographic survey relevant to the above 6 side street locations referenced above. These survey services include but are
 - 1. <u>Topographic Survey</u>: A topographic survey will be performed along the route as shown on Attachment 'B' (See subconsultant backup in Exhibit 'B'). This survey will tie in all visible features such as, but not limited to, signs, light poles, guardrails, utilities, walks, edge of pavement, curbing, drainage structures, etc. These locations will show all features within the corridor from right of way to right of way extending to 25 feet outside the proposed right of way (if provided prior to start of the field work).
 - 2. <u>Cross Sections and DTM</u>: Cross sections will be done along the route at 100-foot intervals. These cross sections will cover the roadway to the right of way lines and extend to 25 feet outside of the right of way (if provided prior to start of the field work). In addition, we will prepare a TIN file and all the corresponding break lines for the design of the roadway. Since a TIN is required this will entail additional shots to be taken on the cross sections to accurately depict the existing conditions. Some areas are thick and will require line cutting. Limits are
- D. Due to changes described in sections A and B above and project timeline, additional permitting activities will be required for the following:
 - 1. SFWMD ERP Permit 50-09041-P (Extension granted until 6-11-2016)
 - 2. ACOE SAJ-2005-2878 (IP-EGR) (Extension granted until 3-6-2017)
 - 3. PBC ERM Excavation Permit (Pending Approval/Exemption)
 - 4. ITID Drainage Connection Permit (Pending Approval)
 - 5. PBC ERM Protection of Native Vegetation PNV-2013-007 (Extension granted until 2017)

The effort associated with all Agencies listed above will include 1 meeting (per Agency) in order to determine what modifications are required to each respective application, as well as all effort to incorporate said modifications. One Agency review and subsequent resubmittal is anticipated.

No additional permit fees are associated for this effort.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

We will perform a topographic survey under this project and the survey work will be performed in accordance with the current *Palm Beach County Thoroughfare Road Design Procedures Manual* (February 2006). This is not an update of the original survey to current standards, only the new topographic survey will meet today's standards. We will not update or make any changes to the original survey from 2002. No work will be performed on the original survey. We will address County comments on this new portion only.

I. CONTROL

Using the information supplied by Palm Beach County and the survey previously prepared by this office (B&P Project # 02-040), we will find/establish horizontal and vertical control for Seminole Pratt Whitney Road. The limits of the survey are from shown on Attachment 'B'.

II. RIGHT-OF-WAY

No new title review is included. We will show the right-of-way based on the survey previously prepared. No search of the Public Records will be performed by Brown & Phillips.

III. VERTICAL PROJECT NETWORK CONTROL

A level run will be performed along the route using the existing Palm Beach County benchmarks (NAVD 1988). Benchmarks will be set along the route, not exceeding 600 feet apart. All benchmarks will be set outside of the proposed limits of construction.

IV. BASELINE LAYOUT

There will be no baseline layout as part of this project.

V. REFERENCE POINTS

No reference points will be set as part of this project.

VI. SECTION TIES AND PROPERTY TIES

We will use the control from the survey previously prepared (B&P Project #02-040), and no additional control points will be located.

VII. TOPOGRAPHY

A topographic survey will be performed along the route as shown on Attachment 'B'. This survey will tie in all visible features such as, but not limited to, signs, light poles, guardrails, utilities, walks, edge of pavement, curbing, drainage structures, etc. These locations will show all features within the corridor from right of way to right of way extending to 25 feet outside the proposed right of way (if provided prior to start of the field work).

VIII. CROSS SECTIONS and TIN CREATION (DTM)

Cross sections will be done along the route at 100-foot intervals. These cross sections will cover the roadway to the right of way lines and extend to 25 feet outside of the right of way (if provided prior to start of the field work). 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
