



Reginald "Reggie" A. Cox is a licensed architect, building official, state certified plans examiner, and building inspector. He founded Reginald A. Cox and Associates, Inc. in 2006. Mr. Cox is the first African American licensed architect born and raised in Palm Beach County who established an architectural practice. Mr. Cox serves on multiple advisory boards. He is currently the Chair of Delray Beach Community Redevelopment Agency, and he is past Chair of the West Atlantic Redevelopment Coalition. He also served on Delray Beach's Site Plan Review and Appearance Board, Board of Adjustment, Parking Management Advisory Board, and Historic Preservation Board. Cox's interest in architecture began at the age of 12 when he took a wood shop class at Carver Middle School. He graduated from Palm Beach Community College with an associate's degree in design and drafting, and then went on to Florida A&M University, where he earned two bachelor's degrees; a B.S. in Architectural Studies and a B.A. Architecture. He also earned MBA from the University of Phoenix. Mr. Cox is currently pursuing a Master's Degree in Urban and Regional Planning.

Glenn Weiss has spent 25 years assisting counties, cities, museums and community organizations to improve their civic spaces with sculpture, murals, landscape, video and performance. He developed the first comprehensive public art and performance program for NYC's Times Square with 300,000 daily visitors. Glenn also managed the Art of Community Initiative for the Community Foundation of Broward. Weiss has been an art consultant in south Florida preparing public art master plans for numerous cities and counties. Other achievements include management of public art programs for Broward and King counties. He also blogs the Aesthetic Grounds column for ArtsJournal.com. In 2013, his "Dark Serra" - a giant painting in a Houston parking lot - was recognized in the Year in Review by the Public Art Network of Americans for the Arts. In Palm Beach County, Weiss is better known for curating the Pineapple Grove Artwalk and Delray Beach Cultural Loop between 2001-2004. He holds a Master of Architecture from Columbia University, NYC.

Mariela Acuna is an art educator and arts professional at the Norton Museum of Art as the Art After Dark Coordinator. She previously worked at the University Galleries at Florida Atlantic University, Girls' Club Collection, Fort Lauderdale and interned at Lehmann Maupin, New York. Acuna co-curated New Art: South Florida, an exhibition of recent works by artists awarded the 2015 South Florida Cultural Consortium Visual and Media Artist Fellowship. Acuna is a collaborator for Cabbage Palm, a South Florida based blog about art and palm trees. She earned a BA in Art History and a BFA in Sculpture from Florida Atlantic University.

Michiko Kurisu is a visual artist. She holds a BFA from Brown University, studied photography at the Rhode Island School of Design, and ceramics in Japan. She has received public art commissions from the City of Delray Beach, Cultural Council of Palm Beach County Artist-in-Residence grant, and produced documentary exhibits with local not-for-profit organizations. Michiko previously served on Delray Beach's Public Art Advisory Board. Working with her family business, Kurisu LLC, a Japanese garden design and build firm, Michiko managed the interface between art, landscape and the public with world-renowned

institutions such as the Frederik Meijer Gardens and Sculpture Park, and the Morikami Museum.

Carolyn Pendleton Parker has 40 years experience in the practice of landscape architecture, hardscape design and landscape implementation, at the International, regional and local scale. Her design philosophy integrates landscape architecture, green infrastructure and ecologic art. her affiliations include the American Society of Landscape Architects, South Florida Ecologic Art Advisory Board, International Association for Landscape Ecology, Delray Beach Public Art Advisory Board, Native Plant Society of Florida and The Cultural Landscape Foundation. She holds a Master of Landscape Architecture Harvard University Graduate School of Design, Cornell University programs in civil planning and tree botany and a BFA, Florida Atlantic.

Sherryl Muriente Tolentino is Project Director at Street Plans. She has extensive experience in urban acupuncture, design, public art and architecture. She has collaborated on projects in Taiwan, Italy, Puerto Rico and South Florida. Prior to joining Street Plans she worked as an urban design instructor at Florida Atlantic University where she managed the international exchange program, mentored students, and presented her work in Tactical Urbanism, community storytelling and the human layer of planning and design.
