I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- **A)** Memorandum of Agreement with the Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County providing additional funding in FY 2017 of up to \$75,000 for the Drowning Prevention Coalition for swimming lessons for the period April 1, 2017 to September 30, 2017; and
- **B)** Budget Amendment of \$75,000 within the Fire/Rescue MSTU Fund to recognize the additional funding from the Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County.

Summary: The Drowning Prevention Coalition program is managed by Palm Beach County Fire-Rescue. It is funded by multiple sources, including the Children's Services Council (CSC) of Palm Beach County and the County's General Fund. This Memorandum of Agreement provides the terms and conditions of the Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County's commitment to the County to provide additional funding of up to \$75,000 in FY 2017 for the Drowning Prevention Coalition program to fund vouchers issued for swimming lessons this summer. Countywide (PK)

Background and Justification: The Palm Beach County Drowning Prevention Coalition program was relocated to Palm Beach County Fire-Rescue on October 1, 2000. The relocation gave the Drowning Prevention Coalition office space within Palm Beach County Fire-Rescue. The primary funding sources for this program in FY 2017 were a transfer from the County's General Fund in the amount of \$169,389 and two agreements with the Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County in the amount of \$125,000.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement, entered into as of this day of, 2017 by and between the CHILDREN'S SERVICES
COUNCIL OF PALM BEACH COUNTY (hereinafter referred to as "CSC"), a political subdivision of the State of
Florida and PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board
of County Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "PBCBCC"), effective April 1, 2017 ("Effective
Date") to September 30, 2017.

CSC has agreed to provide funding, not to exceed **\$75,000** to PBCBCC for the **Drowning Prevention Initiative**, to cover vouchers for swimming lessons for approximately 1,500 children in Palm Beach County, for the period April 1, 2017 through September 30, 2017.

CSC, as one of the funders of Drowning Prevention Initiative, agrees to transfer funds to PBCBCC in accordance with the following schedule and terms:

1. Transfers from CSC to the PBCBCC for expenditures made prior to October 7, 2017 for services on or before September 30, 2017 will be made within 45 days of receipt of written request for funds sent to:

- 2. PBCBCC agrees to refund any of CSC's money advanced but not expended prior to October 7, 2017 for services on or before September 30, 2017 within 30 days.
- 3. A final financial compilation report, accompanied by a Financial Reconciliation Statement (Exhibit "A") accounting for all funds expended will be provided to CSC no later than November 14, 2017.
- 4. Both parties are aware that the inspector General of Palm Beach County has the authority to investigate and audit matters relating to the negotiation and performance of this Agreement, and in furtherance thereof may demand and obtain records and testimony from the either or both parties and their subcontractors and lower tier subcontractors. Both parties understand and agree that in addition to all other remedies and consequences provided by law, the failure of one of the parties or its subcontractors or lower tier subcontractors to fully cooperate with the Inspector General when requested may be deemed by the other party to be a material breach of this Agreement justifying its termination.
- 5. No provision of this Contract is intended to, or shall be construed to, create any third party beneficiary or to provide any rights to any person or entity not a party to this Contract, including but not limited to any citizen or employees of the PBCBCC and/or CSC.

CSC and the PBCBCC agree to comply with the terms of this Memorandum of Agreement.
