**Background and Justification:** WUD's Uniform Policies and Procedures require Standard Development Agreements to obtain concurrency for water and/or wastewater service. The terms and conditions for Standard Development Agreements are outlined in the WUD Uniform Policies and Procedures Manual. The BCC delegated the authority to execute various types of Standard Development Agreements, and related documents including Standard Indemnity Agreements to the Department Director including potable water and wastewater agreements (R93-1619); reclaimed water agreements (R96-0228); and additional conditions for potable water, wastewater and reclaimed water agreements (R2003-0539).

The Agreements have been executed on behalf of the BCC by the Director of WUD in accordance with the authority delegated by the BCC and are now being submitted to the BCC to receive and file.

- A) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with MPC 3, LLC, #01-01250-000 (District 2). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located east of the Florida Turnpike, west of Cleary Rd and south of Belvedere Rd. 17.40 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERCs) for both water and wastewater for five (5) years.
- B) Standard Reclaimed Water Development Agreement with Palm Beach Properties Development Company, LLC, #03-90011-000 (District 5). The Agreement authorizes the property owner located on the west side of Hagen Ranch Rd., approximately 488 feet north of Atlantic Avenue to reserve 5.70 ERICs (Equivalent Residential Irrigation Connections) for Reclaimed Water for five (5) years.
- C) Standard Reclaimed Water Development Agreement with Boynton Beach Associates XXII, LLLP, (District 5). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located on the east side of Lyons Rd. between LWDD L-29 Canal and LWDD L-30 Canal to reserve 392.10 ERICs for Reclaimed Water for five (5) years.
