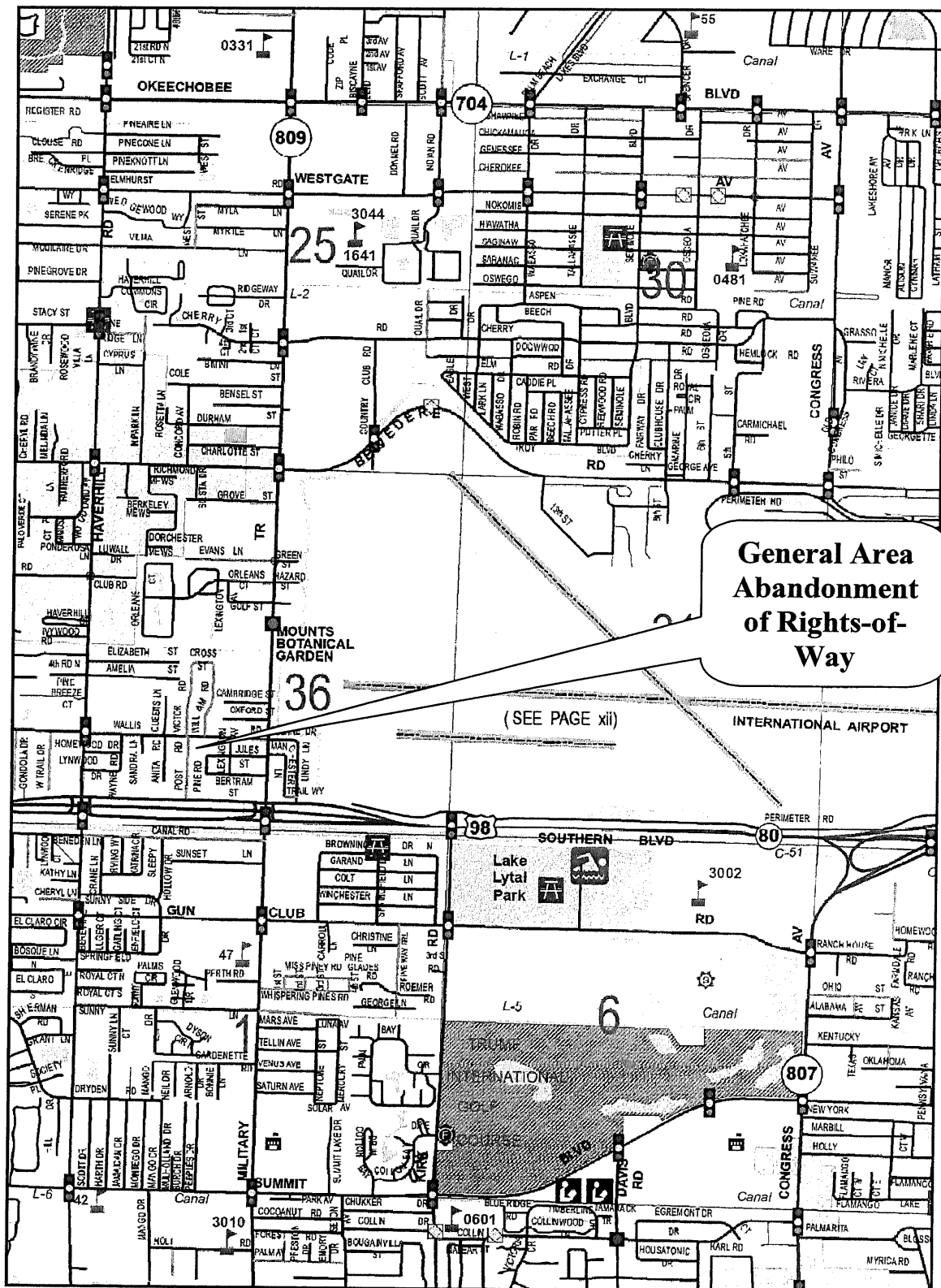

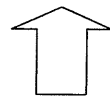

Background and Policy Issues: DOA wants to clear these encumbrances to allow for development of the site. Abandoning these portions of rights-of-way will not affect access to the site.

Reviewing agencies and utility service providers support this abandonment. Replacement utility easements covering portions of the abandonment site will be provided, and recorded simultaneously with the abandonment. As provided in Palm Beach County Code Chapter 22. Article III, Road Abandonment and Plat Vacation (Ordinance 2002-034), the Engineering Department advertised this petition for a public hearing on Sunday, June 4, 2017.
