Summary: This project was advertised utilizing the County's competitive bid process. On June 8, 2017, one (1) bid was received for the Runway Signage and Marking Re-Designation of the three (3) GA Airports for Palm Beach County Department of Airports: PHK, LNA, and F45. Although only one bid was received for this work, staff recommends approval of this contract due to the critical nature of this effort regarding compliance with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) regulations to amend procedures at the airports, along with the recent availability of funding from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). H.L. Pruitt Corp., a Seminole County, Florida company has been identified as the lowest responsible/responsive bidder in the amount of \$1,031,572. The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Goal for this project was established at 9%. H.L. Pruitt Corp. has satisfied the DBE requirement by meeting the DBE participation goal. FDOT funds of \$804,289 and Airport Local funds of \$227,283 are being utilized to fund this project.					
Background and Justification: At airports throughout the world, runways are numbered based on their magnetic or compass heading. Likewise, simple instruments used by pilots for aircraft navigation are designed to determine headings by locating magnetic north through the use of a compass or other device. Due to the fact that runways are fixed in their location, but the Earth's surface experiences changes in the magnetic poles, the magnetic heading of the runway may also change over time. When this occurs, a change in runway numbering may be necessary due to the magnetic variation change. This change is currently necessary at all three (3) of the County's GA airports – PHK, LNA and F45. As such, several changes need to occur to account for this change, including a physical re-numbering/re-painting of the large numerals at the end of each affected runway, as well as a change to all airfield signs and surface painted markings on the airfield that contain a reference to the runway numbers. A similar project was completed at Palm Beach International Airport (PBI) in 2009. Builder's Risk Insurance is not required for this project.


