SCOPE OF WORK FOR

Priority Aerial Canal Crossing Improvements

INTRODUCTION

Palm Beach County (County) entered into an agreement entitled Contract for Pipeline Continuing Construction Services - Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department Project No. WUD 16-067 (CONTRACT) with Hinterland Group, Inc. (CONTRACTOR) to provide construction services for various general activities on the Pipeline Continuing Construction Contract dated January 10, 2017, (R2017-0072). This Work Authorization will be performed under that CONTRACT.

This Work Authorization encompasses providing services related to Priority Aerial Canal Crossing Project.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Contractor shall perform the engineering Scope of Services as described herein to furnish and install all materials necessary to complete the Priority Aerial Canal Crossing Project which includes but is not limited to furnished material, labor supervision, equipment, supplies, fees, expertise, and services necessary to fully complete work in accordance with the Construction Documents and governing regulations. The four (4) aerial canal crossing to be rehabilitated include: Two (2) crossings, 12-inch water main and 20-inch wastewater force main at Lake Worth Drainage District (LWDD) L14 Canal and Ohio Road, two (2) crossings, 8-inch water main and 10-inch wastewater force main at LWDD L-10 Canal and Sherwood Forest Boulevard, two (2) crossings at LWDD L14 Canal and Military Trail, and one (1) crossing at LWDD L2 Canal and Bridgeman Drive.

COMPENSATION

Compensation shall not exceed \$765,220.20 in accordance with the unit prices established in the Contract for construction services dated January 10, 2017 as approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

SBE PARTICIPATION

SBE participation is included in **ATTACHMENT F** under this Authorization. The attached Schedule 1 defines the SBE applied to this Authorization/Contract and Schedule 2 establishes the SBE contribution from each subcontractor (Letter of Intent to perform as an SBE).
