


I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve and select: Michael McCurdy for appointment by the Town of Lantana, as Trustee, on the Lantana Firefighters' Pension Fund Board to fill a vacancy for an unexpired term ending on September 28, 2018.

Summary: Pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement (R97-1252D) Renewing Pension Agreement Relating to Firefighters' Pension Plan (R2010-0215) with the Town of Lantana (Town), the Town is requesting the County's approval of its selection to appoint Michael McCurdy, a Town resident, to fill a vacancy left by the resignation of Timothy Daley. Mr. Daley's term was set to expire on September 28, 2018. Under the Interlocal Agreement, the Town retained the power and responsibility to make appointments to the Fund's Board of Trustees for its Chapter 175 plan. Any Trustee to be appointed by the Town first must be approved by the County. The Board consists of five members, with four seats currently filled and a diversity count of Caucasian: 4 (100%). The current gender ratio (male:female) is 4:0. Mr. McCurdy is a Caucasian male. District 7 (SB)

Background and Justification: Pursuant to Florida law and direction from the State Division of Retirement Services, the Town's employees who were transferred to County employment under the prior 1997 service agreement, were given a one-time election to stay in the local retirement system or come into the Florida Retirement System (FRS). All of the then, current Town employees chose to remain in their existing pension plan that is authorized under Chapter 175, Florida Statutes. That pension plan maintains a separate Board of Trustees (5 members), two of whom must be legal residents of the Town of Lantana. The Town selects and appoints these two appointees upon approval by the County.





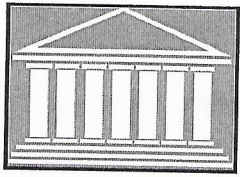

Dear Carrie-Ann:

As you know, we serve as the Administrator for the Lantana Firefighters' Pension Fund. This is in regard to the Trustees that sit on the Board of the Fund.

As you may recall, the Board of County Commissioners approved the selection of Timothy Daley for appointment by the Town of Lantana to the Lantana Firefighters' Pension Fund on August 16, 2016. After his appointment Mr. Daley was advised by his employer that he could not serve as a Trustee on the Board. His employer stated that he was prohibited by law from being a deputy sheriff and also serving on the Board. As such, Mr. Daley resigned as a Trustee on the Board. Mr. Daley's term expires on September 28, 2018.

The Board has received a letter of interest from Michael McCurdy to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term. See attached. As this position is that of a Town resident, he needs to be approved by the County and then ratified by the Town of Lantana pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement between Palm Beach County and the Town of Lantana. As such, the Board would ask that you please take the appropriate action to have the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners approve the selection of Michael McCurdy for appointment by the Town of Lantana to the Lantana Firefighters' Pension Fund for the unexpired term of Mr. Daley as soon as possible. Please advise us in writing once the Commission has approved the selection so that we can have the Town appoint Mr. McCurdy to the Board.
