I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Amendment No. 3 to the Contract for Water Treatment Plant No. 8 (WTP 8) Anion Exchange System Design and Construction Services with Globaltech, Inc. (R2014-1589) in the amount of \$62,108.48 with an associated increase in the term of the Contract of one (1) year.

Summary: On October 21, 2014, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Water Utilities Department (WUD) Engineering/Professional Services Contract (Contract) for design and construction services for the WTP 8 anion exchange system with Globaltech, Inc. WUD is expanding the anion exchange treatment system to improve the water quality and demolishing the energy intensive ozone system at WTP 8 (Project). Amendment No. 3 provides for additional engineering services during construction of the Project. The term of the Contract also requires extension from three (3) years to four (4) years to provide for the completion of construction and project closeout to match the construction contract associated with the Project. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation established by the SBE is 15% overall. The Contract with Globaltech, Inc. provides for SBE participation of 75% overall. Amendment No. 3, is 97.45% overall. Globaltech, Inc. is a Palm Beach County company. This Project is included in the FY18 Capital Improvement Plan adopted by the BCC. (WUD Project No. 13-022) <u>District 2</u> (MJ)

Background and Justification: Amendment No. 1 (R2015-0878) to the Contract expanded the design consultant's scope of services to add a new sanitary sewer lift station and sludge pond pump station. Amendment No. 2 (R2016-0373) provided for engineering services during construction of the WTP 8 anion exchange expansion project, increasing the Contract amount by \$780,664.90. Amendment No. 3 increases the contract amount by \$62,108.48 and provides for additional engineering services during construction including asset management. The Contract for engineering services with Globaltech, Inc. expires on October 20, 2017 and the construction contract with R.J. Sullivan Corp. has a completion date of March 10, 2018. Amendment No. 3 includes a one-year extension of the contract term for construction observation and contract closeout to match the corresponding construction contract.



THIRD AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT FOR ENGINEERING / PROFESSIONAL CONSULTING SERVICES WATER TREATMENT PLANT NO. 8 ANION EXCHANGE SYSTEM ENGINEERING DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION SERVICES PROJECT NO. WUD 13-022 (TR04)

This Amendment is made as of the day of ______20 _____, by and between Palm Beach County, a Political Subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY, and Globaltech, Inc. [] an individual, [] a partnership, [X] a corporation authorized to do business in the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the ENGINEER, whose Federal I.D. is 65-0577611.

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER agree that the Contract for ENGINEERING / Professional Consulting Services entered into by the parties on October 21, 2014, and referenced by County Resolution Number R2014-1589 (hereinafter "the Contract"), is amended as follows:

- 1. Additional services (Tasks 11 to 12) are provided as contained in Exhibit A3 attached hereto and made a part hereof. Tasks 1 to 4 were completed under the original scope of work, R2014-1589. Tasks 5 to 10 are currently underway and were included in Amendment No. 2, R2016-0373.
- 2. The compensation in R2014-1589 was a lump sum fee of \$982,499.23 plus an additional not to exceed amount of \$14,025.00 for a total of \$996,524.23. The lump sum amount was increased by \$56,640.18 from \$982,499.23 to \$1,039,139.41 in Amendment No. 1 (R2015-0878). The lump sum amount was increased by \$780,664.90 from \$1,039,139.41 to \$1,819,804.31 in Amendment No. 2, (R2016-0373). The lump sum amount is hereby increased by \$62,108.48 from \$1,819,804.31 to \$1,881,912.79 and the total compensation including the not to exceed amount of \$14,025.00 is \$1,895,937.79 as contained in Exhibit B3 attached hereto and made part hereof.
- 3. The period of service as provided in R2014-1589 was a term of three (3) years. The period of service is hereby increased by one (1) year and the term shall be four (4) years from the effective date of October 21, 2014 as contained in Exhibit C3 attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 4. The SBE schedules 1 and 2 are contained in Exhibit D3 attached hereto and made a part hereof for the additional services contained in this Amendment.

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All other provisions in the Contract remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

EXHIBIT A3 SCOPE OF WORK

BACKGROUND

The design, permitting, and bidding of a new anion exchange system at Water Treatment Plant #8 have been completed by the ENGINEER under this CONTRACT. Construction of the new anion exchange system is underway to replace the existing ozone system to remove organics and color from the water. The COUNTY has requested that the ENGINEER provide additional support services associated with the construction and commissioning of the project as an Amendment to this CONTRACT.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

ENGINEER shall perform the following engineering support services associated with the construction and commissioning of the new anion exchange system at COUNTY WTP NO. 8.

The following engineering support services have been based upon the direction provided by COUNTY staff. Tasks 1 through 4 were completed under the original scope of work. With construction progressing, Tasks 5 through 10 are in progress or remain to be conducted. Amendment 3 contains the following 3 additional tasks (Task 11 through 12):

Task 11 Additional Construction Administration

The construction project is anticipated to be extended an additional 96 days for additional work added to the contract and for unforeseen delays. ENGINEER and ENGINEER's Subconsultants, Hillers Electrical Engineering (HEE) will continue to provide construction administration and site for the extend time period.

- <u>Project Management/Coordination.</u> The ENGINEER shall provide additional assistance to the COUNTY during construction of the improvements. The Engineer shall coordinate with the COUNTY and Contractor. ENGINEER will assist COUNTY with review of monthly payment requests submitted by CONTRACTOR.
- <u>Construction Progress Meetings</u>. The ENGINEER shall prepare the agenda, attend and participate in regular construction progress meetings. ENGINEER shall prepare meeting Agenda. Discussion topics, action items, and decisions made at these meeting will be recorded in the meeting minutes by the ENGINEER. For the purposes of this scope of work it is anticipated that there will be two meetings per month for three addition months.
- <u>Site Visits</u>. The ENGINEER shall provide additional specialty inspection services for the extended time period. Primary inspection services shall be provided by COUNTY staff. The ENGINEER shall provide additional specialty inspection services by engineers experienced in the identified discipline fields.

Task 12 Asset Management Assistance

ENGINEER and ENGINEER's Subconsultant, Hillers Electrical Engineering (HEE) shall assist the COUNTY's in review of the Electronic Equipment Data Sheets. The ENGINEER shall review data sheets provided by Contractor and confirm information on data sheet. Data review shall consist of review of Operation and Maintenance Manuals information and site visits to confirm model and serial numbers.

Services Not Included in Scope of Services

- Patent related dispute services.
- Litigation services.
- Permitting application fees.
- > Additional services not otherwise provided for in this Scope of Services.

COMPENSATION

The ENGINEER will be compensated in accordance with the budget contained in the original CONTRACT amended with the attached budget summary (Exhibit B3), a lump sum amount of <u>\$62,108.48</u>. Monthly progress payments will be authorized based on percent complete as determined by ENGINEER and approved by the COUNTY.

OTHER PROVISIONS

All exclusions and additional provisions agreed to in the original contract are to remain in full effect during the implementation of the project. Certain assumptions have been made in preparing this Scope of Services. To the extent possible, these assumptions are stated herein and are reflected in the budget for services.

- If the work tasks required are different from the assumptions presented herein or if ENGINEER/COUNTY desires additional services, the resulting change in scope may serve as a basis for modifying this Amendment's scope and fee as agreed to by both COUNTY and ENGINEER.
- Consistent with the professional standard of care and unless specifically provided herein, ENGINEER shall be entitled to rely upon the accuracy of data and information provided by the COUNTY or others without independent review or evaluation.
- It is anticipated that the project and Task specific durations will follow the schdule presented in Exhibit C3 – Project Schedule. Should the project duration exceed the durations estimated, Amendment's scope and fee shall be modified as agreed to by both COUNTY and ENGINEER.
- ENGINEER is not responsible for the means, methods, sequences, techniques or procedures of the COUNTY or the COUNTY Contractor's operations or safety precautions and programs.
- COUNTY will pay for all permit fees.
