# **I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF**

Motion and Title: Staff recommends a motion to approve Re-appointment of two current members to the Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB).

#### Summary:

The CILB was established by Special Act, Laws of Florida, Chapter 67-1876, as amended. The Special Act and, subsequently, 489.131, Florida Statutes (F.S.) sets forth the membership of the Board, which consists of fifteen members. The nominations for re-appointment of two members are as follows: Mr. Gerald Kelly has been nominated by the Associated General Contractors Association (AGC) to serve his first 3-year term. Mr. Sam Roman is the chairman of the Puerto Rican/Hispanic Chamber of Commerce and has indicated a willingness to serve his first 3-year term. The nominations represent the seat for one General Contractor, and one Consumer Representative as cited in the Special Act, and F.S. establishing the CILB. Memorandums for appointments and endorsements were sent to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on July 24, 2017. No other nominations were received. The CILB has fifteen seats currently filled and a diversity count of Caucasian: 11 (73.33%) and Hispanic-American: 4 (26.67%). The gender ratio (female: male) is 0:15. Mr. Kelly is a Caucasian male and Mr. Roman is a Hispanic-American male.

Mr. Gerald Kelly has disclosed that he is an officer employed by The Weitz Company LLC that contracts with the County to provide construction services through sealed bids. The Construction Industry Licensing Board of Palm Beach County provides no regulation, oversight, management, or policy-setting recommendations regarding the subject contract(s). Disclosure of this contractual relationship at a duly noticed public meeting is being provided in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 2-443, of the Palm Beach County Code of Ethics. Countywide (SF)

#### **Background and Justification:**

The membership of the Board consists of two general contractors, and one member of the following categories: building, residential, electrical, plumbing, HARV (Heating, Air Conditioning, Refrigeration and Ventilation), roofing, swimming pool, architect, engineer, and building official. In addition, 489.131, F.S. requires that we have three Consumer Representatives. The Board establishes qualifications and competency of contractors that work within the County. The Board also provides for the testing and licensing of these contractors, and is empowered to discipline licenses.

Re: Nominations to the Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB) of Palm Beach County

ITEM: The purpose of this memo is to advise of two nominations for reappointment to the Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB). The first re-appointment is for Mr. Gerry Kelly who currently serves on the General Contractor Seat. The second re-appointment is for Mr. Sam Roman who currently serves on the Consumer Seat. Mr. Kelly was nominated by the Associated General Contractors Association (AGC) and appointed by the Board of County Commission (BCC) September 2015. Mr. Roman is the President of the Puerto Rican/Hispanic Chamber of Commerce who was appointed by the BCC August 2015. At the time Mr. Kelly and Mr. Roman were appointed, they filled unexpired terms left vacant by prior Board members with an expiration date of September 30, 2017. As such, both Mr. Kelly and Mr. Roman are now eligible to commence their first full 3-year term which would run from October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2020. The members of the BCC may also nominate candidates for these two CILB seats. Once all the nominations are received, they will be reviewed by staff to ensure nominees meet appointment requirements and then presented to the BCC for appointment.

**BACKGROUND:** The primary function of the CILB is for approval of certificate of competency construction trade licenses for Palm Beach County. The CILB consists of fifteen specified construction trade members per Special Act, including three consumer members who may be nominated by the BCC. The term of office of each member is three years, with two consecutive year terms. The meetings are held once a month on the fourth Monday of each month. The qualification to be appointed to this board is to be actively engaged in the construction business in Palm Beach County; hold a certificate of competency under the nominee's name; engaged for a period of not less than five consecutive years immediately before the date of his appointment; and be a resident of Palm Beach County. The architect and engineer members shall be licensed in the State of Florida and be a



resident of Palm Beach County. The consumer representative may be any resident of the local jurisdiction who is not, and has never been, a member or practitioner of a profession regulated by the CILB or a member of any closely related profession. The CILB currently filled fifteen (15) seats show a diversity count of 11 Caucasian (73.33%) and 4 Hispanic-American (26.67%). The gender ratio (female: male) is 0:15. Mr. Kelly is a Caucasian male and Mr. Roman is a Hispanic-American male.

#### Special Act, Laws of Florida, Chapter 67-1876, as amended

Section 3. Construction Industry Licensing Board of Palm Beach County, organization, meetings, powers, duties. --

(A) The Construction Industry Licensing Board of Palm Beach County is hereby created and composed of the following: two general contractors, one contractor who is primarily engaged in the business of furnishing those services to which a building contractor is limited, one contractor who is primarily engaged in the business of furnishing those services to which a residential contractor is limited, one electrical contractor, one plumbing contractor, one HARV contractor, one roofing contractor, one swimming pool contractor, one architect, one engineer, and one full-time building official, employed by a local government within Palm Beach County who meets the requirements of the Building Officials Association of Florida. All members of the Board shall be appointed by the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners.

(B) To be eligible for appointment each contractor member shall be:

(1) Actively engaged in the construction business in Palm Beach County and have held a certificate of competency in his name and have been so engaged for a period of not less than 5 consecutive years immediately before the date of his appointment, and be a resident of Palm Beach County. The architect and engineer member shall be licensed in the State of Florida and be a resident of Palm Beach County.

(2) Each member of the Board except the Building Official shall hold a valid certificate issued by this Board or the state of Florida in addition to having the qualifications required in subsection (B) (1) above.

(C) All terms of office expire on September 30 of the last year of term. As the terms of members expire, the Board of County Commissioners shall appoint a member to fill the vacancy for a term of 3 years, but no member shall serve for more than two consecutive terms but may be reappointed after a three (3) year hiatus. Vacancies in the membership of the board for any cause shall be filled by the Board of County Commissioners for the balance of the unexpired term.

#### F.S. § 489.131 Applicability:

(10) No municipal or county government may issue any certificate of competency or license for any contractor defined in s. 489.105(3)(a)-(o) after July 1, 1993, unless such local government exercises disciplinary control and oversight over such locally licensed contractors, including forwarding a recommended order in each action to the board as provided in subsection (7).

Each local board that licenses and disciplines contractors must have at least two consumer representatives on that board. If the board has seven or more members, at least three of those members must be consumer representatives. The consumer representative may be any resident of the local jurisdiction who is not, and has never been, a member or practitioner of a profession regulated by the board or a member of any closely related profession.  $(7 \cdot 1 \cdot 93)$
