I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Authorization (WA) No. 7 for the GL06; SW Belle Glade Water Main Improvements; SW 8th Street, SW 9th Street, and SW 4th Street from SW Avenue F to Dr. Martin Luther King Boulevard (Project) with Hinterland Group, Inc., in the amount of \$1,389,257.38

Summary: On January 10, 2017 the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Pipeline Continuing Construction Contract (Contract) with Hinterland Group, Inc. (R2017-0072). WA No. 7 provides for the installation of approximately 3,000 feet of 4-inch, 6-inch and 8-inch water mains, including fire hydrants and service lines to improve the water system infrastructure and the fire protection in Belle Glade. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance is 15% overall. The Contract with Hinterland Group, Inc., provides for SBE participation of 15%. WA No. 7 includes 100% overall participation. The cumulative SBE participation, including WA No. 7 is 100% overall. Hinterland Group, Inc., is a Palm Beach County company. The Project is included WUD's FY18 Budget. (WUD Project No. 16-053) District 6 (MJ)

Background and Justification: The Project will be undertaken in a geographic area bounded by Dr. Martin Luther King Boulevard, SW 14th Street, SW Avenue F and SW 2nd Street. The area additionally contains locations where water services need to be converted from the existing rear lot water mains to the front lots. In addition, all of the existing rear lot water mains need to be deactivated. The Project provides for the conversion of the remainder of the rear lot water services within the Project area, deactivation of the water main along SW Avenue F and deactivation of the existing rear lot water mains within the area. The Project area predominately contains substandard water mains that are in poor condition due to age and corrosion that have a high incidence of breaks and leaks. Water main improvement will enhance the system reliability and will also increase fire protection in the surrounding area. These improvements are part of the continued restoration and repair of vital water infrastructure in the Glades and will ensure the provision of high quality water delivery to the residents and business.

INTRODUCTION

Palm Beach County (County) entered into an agreement entitled Contract for Pipeline Continuing Construction Services - Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department Project No. WUD 16-077 (CONTRACT) with Hinterland Group, Inc. (CONTRACTOR) to provide construction services for various general activities on the Pipeline Continuing Construction Contract dated January 10th 2017, (R2017-0072). This Work Authorization will be performed under that CONTRACT.

This Work Authorization encompasses providing services related to SW Belle Glade Water Services Replacement Project – 4th, 8th and 9th Street
