	Each county officer of whom bond is, or shall be required by law, shall give bond to the governor of the State, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of his/her office.
	Palm Beach County Ordinance 98-51 outlines the various bond amounts of each elected official. These are referenced on attached report for examination. All bonds are listed in compliance with Chapter 98-34, Laws of Florida Section 137.05, F.S.) and Ordinance 98-51.

12	WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature enacted Chapter 98-34,
13	Laws of Florida, eliminating or revising bond requirements for
14	certain public officials, including specified County officers; and
15	WHEREAS, Chapter 98-34 eliminated the statutory bond

17	Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") may establish bond
