I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Budget Transfer of \$725,000 within the Fire Rescue Impact Fees Fund from the New Tactical Command Unit project to Fire Rescue Capital Reserves to temporarily defund this project until adequate Fire Rescue Impact Fees are collected.

Summary: Fire Rescue currently has one (1) recently refurbished Tactical Command Unit (TCU). On March 11, 2014, the Board approved a budget transfer of \$725,000 from Impact Fees Reserves to fund the purchase of a new Mobile Incident Command Post (MICP) vehicle. Due to the current cash balance in the Fire Rescue Impact Fees Fund, staff is requesting to temporarily defund the New Tactical Command Unit project in order to ensure sufficient funding is available for higher priority projects. When sufficient Fire Rescue Impact Fees have been collected, budget for the New Tactical Command Unit project will be reestablished. <u>Countywide</u> (SB)

Background and Justification: Fire Rescue currently has one (1) TCU that is used to effectively respond and provide emergency disaster relief to all residents, businesses and visitors to the County with specialized on-scene National Incident Management System (NIMS) functions including: command, control, communication & coordination of multi disasters (hurricanes, flooding, tornadic activity), all fire fatalities, civil unrest, aircraft incidents, extended power outages, cyber attacks, terrorism, planned special events, active shooter/barricaded subject, HAZMAT incidents, and mutual aid callouts. Based on the County's large geographical area, residential and occupied business growth throughout the County, the Board approved the purchase of a new Mobile Incident Command Post vehicle. Due to the immediate need for Fire Rescue Impact Fees to fund higher priority projects, staff is requesting the MICP vehicle purchase be delayed until adequate Fire Rescue Impact Fees have been collected.
