I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: a Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida amending the work identification card application and duplicate card fees for individuals performing in adult entertainment establishments; repealing and replacing Resolution No. 2008-2350; and providing for an effective date.

Summary: This proposed amendment to the resolution increases fees for a new work ID from \$75 to \$100 and for a duplicate copy from \$25 to \$30. The current fees set in 2008 have not generated sufficient revenue to offset the cost of the department to administer the program. Approximately 700 applications are processed annually. The cost of the program is approximately \$81,000 per year, which includes personnel costs, identification card equipment and supplies, and other administrative costs. <u>Countywide</u> (LDC)

Background and Policy Issues: Because of numerous concerns of minors performing in adult entertainment establishments, in July 1999, the Board of County Commissioners amended Chapter 17, Article V of the Palm Beach County Code (Adult Entertainment Code) to require performers in adult entertainment establishments in Palm Beach County to obtain work ID cards from the Public Safety Department. Section 17-153 of the Adult Entertainment Ordinance requires performers in adult entertainment establishments to apply for work identification (ID) cards from the Public Safety Department and show proof that they are at least eighteen years old. Operators, managers, or owners of adult entertainment establishments shall not allow performers to work without valid work identification cards.

RESOLUTION NO. R-2018 -

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY **COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA** AMENDING THE WORK IDENTIFICATION CARD APPLICATION AND DUPLICATE CARD FEES FOR INDIVIDUALS PERFORMING IN ADULT ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENTS; REPEALING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION NO. 2008-2350; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 17 Article V, Division 1, Section 17-153 of the Palm Beach County Code sets forth provisions relating to the requirement of work identification cards for individuals performing in adult entertainment establishments; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 17 Article V, Division 1, Section 17-153 of the Palm Beach County Code provides that the Board of County Commissioners shall establish the application fee and the duplicate card fee for work identification cards by resolution; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2008-2350 was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners ("BCC") on December 16, 2008 establishing the application fee at Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00) and the duplicate card fee of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00); and

WHEREAS, the fees established in 2008 do not generate sufficient revenues to recoup the costs of administering the program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to revise the application and duplicate card fees as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that

Section 1. <u>Recitals.</u>

The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

Section 2. <u>Fees.</u>

The fee for each new work identification card is established at One Hundred Dollars (\$100) and the fee for each request for a duplicate copy of an existing work identification card is established at Thirty Dollars (\$30).

Section 3. <u>Repeal</u>.

Resolution 2008-2350 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. <u>Effective Date.</u>

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
