### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a resolution to endorse the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant funding for the Westgate Belvedere Homes Community Redevelopment Agency (Westgate CRA) to install sidewalks and streetlights in the Belvedere Heights neighborhood Phase 2 Project (Project).

Summary: Approval of this resolution will comply with a Palm Beach County Transportation Planning Agency (TPA) requirement, that for federally funded projects, a resolution is necessary to establish the local agency's commitment to construct, operate and maintain the project. Since Palm Beach County (County) is a certified agency for the Local Agency Program, the Westgate CRA has requested the County's endorsement and support of the project. The Westgate CRA will be responsible for the design through construction and maintenance, with the County's (Engineering Department) endorsement. District 2 (RPB)

Background and Justification: The TPA requested grant applications from local agencies for the categorical grant funding available from the TAP Program. In response, the Westgate CRA submitted an application for funding to install sidewalks and streetlights in the Belvedere Heights neighborhood. The TPA approved a grant last year for the first five streets of Belvedere Heights (Phase 1). This year's application will cover the remaining three streets. TAP funding typically comes three years after the applications are approved. The Westgate CRA has requested that the County, a certified agency for the Local Agency Program, sponsor the TAP grant application on its behalf. As part of the application process there is a federal requirement that a commitment to construction, operation and maintenance of the project must be established. The TPA has determined that a resolution by the Board of County Commissioners is the proper instrument to comply with the federal requirement for commitment. The Westgate CRA has provided written assurances to the Engineering Department, to pay all costs for operation and maintenance of the project plus all costs that may be over and above the amount of funding approved by the TAP grant. This resolution provides the necessary endorsement for the Westgate CRA to design, construct and maintain the project and support the Westgate CRA's application for funding.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY (COUNTY), FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION TO THE PALM BEACH COUNTY TRANSPORTATION PLANNING AGENCY (TPA) FROM THE WESTGATE BELVEDERE HOMES COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (WESTGATE CRA) FOR THE FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING TO SUPPORT THE INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS AND STREETLIGHTS IN THE BELVEDERE HEIGHTS NEIGHBORHOOD.

WHEREAS, as documentation of sponsorship of the project, the TPA has requested that the County adopt a resolution in support of the project and TAP grant application; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined execution of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) of Palm Beach County, Florida, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Resolution.

At its meeting of March 12, 2018, the Westgate Belvedere Homes Community Redevelopment Agency Board voted unanimously to authorize staff to budget funds to fully fund and maintain the streetlights and the sidewalks for Belvedere Heights if the Transportation Planning Agency (TPA) Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant is approved.
