Summary: The FTA distributes Section 5339 funds to provide public transportation capital grants to assist financing capital projects for bus and bus facilities that will benefit the nation's transit systems. The grant will fund a portion of the construction for the expansion of Palm Tran's South County administrative and maintenance facility, which is currently at full capacity. The current estimated project cost is \$25 million and is expected to be completed in late 2019. On November 5, 2013, the BCC approved the acquisition of the land to expand the existing facility (R2013-1609). The project will increase space for administration, training/orientation and provide additional parking for buses and employees. The final planning approval is estimated to be completed in June 2018, and the projected construction completion date is projected for December 2019. Execution of the FTA award represents the County's legal affirmation to abide by FTA and other federal requirements as described in The Master Agreement FTA MA (24) dated October 1, 2017, submitted for Board Approval on April 10, 2018 under item 3AA1. The grant requires a 20% local match, which is being met by the use of toll revenue credits "soft match" provided by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). The grant also requires execution of a Standard Form LLL - Disclosure of Lobbying Activities. No County funds are required. Countywide (DR)
