**I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF**

**Motion and Title:** Staff recommends motion to adopt: a Resolution to support the installation of fiber-optic communications cable planned on four Palm Beach County (County) roadway sections by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).


**SUMMARY:** Adoption of this Resolution will support the planned installation of fiber-optic communications cable by FDOT on Seminole Pratt Whitney Road (Northlake Boulevard to SR 80), Lyons Road (Lantana Road to Boynton Beach Boulevard), Lawrence Road (Hypoluxo Road to Boynton Beach Boulevard), and Military Trail (Butts Road to Linton Boulevard). The total length of cable to be installed is approximately 22 miles, which will make it possible to add 33 traffic signals and 6 closed circuit television (CCTV) devices to the Palm Beach County Traffic Management System. This project has been prioritized by the Palm Beach County Transportation Planning Agency (TPA) under their Local Initiatives Program for construction in FY 2020. FDOT’s policy requires all local agencies that have jurisdiction or facilities impacted by planned FDOT improvements to adopt a resolution supporting the planned improvements. Countywide (LBH)

**BACKGROUND:** The TPA has prioritized the expansion of the fiber optic communications network to connect traffic signals and devices on Seminole Pratt Whitney Road (Northlake Boulevard to SR 80), Lyons Road (Lantana Road to Boynton Beach Boulevard), Lawrence Road (Hypoluxo Road to Boynton Beach Boulevard), and Military Trail (Butts Road to Linton Boulevard). The FDOT will administer the design and the construction of the project under FM#436897-1-52-01, and will transfer maintenance and operation to the County upon completion in FY 2020. By connecting the 33 traffic signals and the 6 CCTV devices to the County Traffic Management System network, this project will increase the total number of traffic signals online to 835 and the total CCTV devices to 171. The total budget allocated for this project by FDOT is \$2,901,918.



 NORTHLAKE BLVD



**RESOLUTION NO. R-2018-**

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA SUPPORTING THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF FIBER-OPTIC COMMUNICATIONS ON SECTIONS OF SEMINOLE PRATT WHITNEY ROAD, LYONS ROAD, LAWRENCE ROAD, AND MILITARY TRAIL BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.**

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to design and construct fiber-optic communications cable on Seminole Pratt Whitney Road (Northlake Boulevard to SR 80), Lyons Road (Lantana Road to Boynton Beach Boulevard), Lawrence Road (Hypoluxo Road to Boynton Beach Boulevard), and Military Trail (Butts Road to Linton Boulevard); and

**WHEREAS**, Palm Beach County (County) has jurisdiction over, and maintenance responsibility for the sections of roadway described above; and

**WHEREAS**, the County deems it to be in the public interest to support the design and construction of the fiber-optic communications cable network within the County right-of-way for the benefit of connecting additional traffic signals and the closed circuit television (CCTV) devices to the traffic management system network; and

**WHEREAS**, the County permits the FDOT and their contractor to access the county maintained fiber-optic communications conduits, pull boxes, hub-sites, and traffic signal controller cabinet boxes for installing the fiber optic communications cable; and

**WHEREAS**, the County agrees to assume the maintenance and operation of the fiber optic communications infrastructure and the CCTV devices once installed and transferred by the FDOT.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, that the recitations set forth herein above are true, accurate and correct and are incorporated herein.

This Resolution will take effect upon its adoption.
