# I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

# Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to:

- **A)** adopt a Resolution authorizing the conveyance of the County's interest in a 0.21 acre parcel of surplus property improved with a 1,232 SF manufactured home to the City of Belle Glade without charge pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 197.592(3), with reservation of mineral and petroleum rights, but without rights of entry and exploration; and
- **B)** approve a County Deed in favor of the City of Belle Glade.

Summary: In July 2017, the County acquired a 0.21 acre parcel of surplus property improved with a 1,232 SF manufactured home located within the municipal boundaries of the City of Belle Glade by Tax Deed. The parcel serves no present or future County purpose. A recent appraisal valued the property at \$35,000. The parcel is being conveyed to the City pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 197.592(3), which requires the conveyance of surplus properties acquired by tax deed to the municipality in which it is located. This conveyance will relieve the County of potential liability for occurrences on the property. The County will retain mineral and petroleum rights in accordance with Florida Statutes Section 270.11, without rights of entry and exploration. This conveyance must be approved by a Supermajority Vote (5 Commissioners). (PREM) District 6 (HJF)

Background & Policy Issues: In July 2017, the County acquired title to this property by Tax Deed. The property is improved with a 1,232 SF manufactured home that requires major repair. PREM, in response to direction from the Real Estate Assets Task Force, has developed a program to convey to the municipalities in which they are located surplus County property which provides little opportunity to further a County function. Staff feels strongly that the most cost effective method to dispose of this property is to convey the parcel at no cost to the City, as the municipality is in a better position to determine how this property should be used and maintained. Because of its location in a residential area, it is unlikely to be used for anything other than residential purposes. County Administration and the Housing and Economic Sustainability Department were notified and have no objections to the conveyance of the property to the City. This conveyance will relieve the County of potential liability for occurrences on the property. As this property has an assessed value less than \$250,000, review by the Property Review Committee is not required. A Disclosure of Beneficial Interests is also not required.



**RESOLUTION OF** THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF BELLE GLADE PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE SECTION 197.592(3); WITHOUT CHARGE AND WITH MINERAL AND **PETROLEUM** RESERVATION WITHOUT RIGHTS OF ENTRY AND **EXPLORATION**; **AND PROVIDING FOR** EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the County owns one (1) improved parcel within the municipal boundaries of the City of Belle Glade which was acquired for delinquent taxes; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes Section 197.592(3) states that under certain conditions, the County is to convey to municipalities in which they are located, properties acquired by the County for delinquent taxes and that any liens of record held by the County on such properties shall not survive the conveyance to the municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the subject parcel has not been previously sold, acquired for infill housing, or dedicated by the Board of County Commissioners, and shall not be conveyed to the record prior fee simple title owner; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida Statute Section 270.11, the City of Belle Glade has requested that such property be conveyed without reservation of and release the rights of entry and exploration relating to phosphate, mineral, metals and petroleum rights; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County has agreed to convey such property reserving phosphate, mineral, metals and petroleum rights but releasing any and all rights of entry and exploration relating to such rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

# Section 1. Recitals

The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

# Section 2. <u>Authorization to Convey Real Property</u>

The Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County shall convey to the City of Belle Glade without charge and by County Deed attached hereto as Exhibit "A"

and incorporated herein by reference, the real property legally described in such deed. Any liens of record held by the County on the subject lands shall not survive the conveyance to the City of Belle Glade.

### Section 3. **Conflict with Federal or State Law or County Charter**

Any statutory or Charter provisions in conflict with this Resolution shall prevail.

# **COUNTY DEED**

This COUNTY DEED, made \_\_\_\_\_\_, by PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, whose legal mailing address is 2633 Vista Parkway, West Palm Beach, Florida 33411-5605, "County", and the CITY OF BELLE GLADE, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, whose legal mailing address is 110 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard West, Belle Glade, Florida 33430 "City".

# WITNESSETH:

That County, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten and 00/100 (\$10.00) Dollars to it in hand paid by City, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained and sold to City, its successors and assigns forever, the following described land lying and being in Palm Beach County, Florida:
