I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: A) Accept the donation of \$9,035 from the Friends of the Mounts Botanical Garden, Inc. (Friends) to fund the architectural design work for the renovation and expansion of the Garden Shop in the Mounts Botanical Garden of Palm Beach County (Garden); and **(B) approve** a Budget Amendment (Fund 1482) in the amount of \$9,035.

Summary: The Friends have made a donation of \$9,035 to the County for the conceptual design to renovate the gift shop and for the design of the electrical grid in the Garden. The Cooperative Extension Department is working with Facilities Development and Operations (FDO) for this renovation. The renovation and expansion will further enhance the Garden. No ad valorem funding is required for this project. Countywide (AH)

Background and Justification: The renovation and Garden Shop expansion will support the objectives of enhanced revenue generation since more inventory will be displayed with increased aesthetics, and modified traffic flow with turnstiles that will accurately quantify visitor numbers, which is important data for many grant RFPs.




Garden Shop Expansion

Visitors "enter" the Garden through the Garden Shop door






















O Visitors exit the Garden Shop, on the south end that faces the Tropical Forest, and head on the path that leads them through the Garden.









<u>Turnstiles</u> placed at Garden entrance to <u>accurately track attendance</u>
