I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a waiver allowing for the establishment of an impact fee credit, currently estimated to be \$88,200, for improvements to the intersection of Lantana Road and Military Trail.

SUMMARY: Article 13 of the Unified Land Development Code (Article 13) details criteria for impact fee credits. Impact fee credits for roadway improvements that are not required for Palm Beach County's Traffic Performance Standards (TPS) require the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approval. These improvements relate to Development Order Amendment (DOA) approved by the BCC on May 24, 2018 for a gas station, convenience store, and restaurant. As part of the DOA, conditions were included addressing intersection improvements. These improvements are not required to meet TPS. However, the TPS approval letter lists a number of improvements to the intersection impacted by this project. Currently, this location experiences congestion, queuing, and safety issues that are expected to deteriorate with the addition of traffic from this development. District 3 (LB)

Background and Justification: Palm Beach County required certain intersection improvements as conditions of approval for the proposed Wawa project located at the southwest corner of Lantana Road and Military Trail. These improvements are not site related and may be eligible for impact fee credits.

The required improvements are as follows: a) extend the existing dual eastbound left turn lanes; b) mill and resurface eastbound through lanes; and c) extend the existing dual westbound left turn lanes. Article 13 lists three criteria that must be met for an impact fee credit to be allowed. The criteria are detailed below:

- 1. The proposed road construction must be on the major road network: Both Lantana Road and Military Trail are on the Thoroughfare Right-of-Way Identification Map and are considered to be part of the major road network;
- 2. The proposed road construction must not be site-related improvements: None of the improvements will directly access the site. For this reason, the improvements are not considered site related; and
- 3. The proposed road construction must be required to meet the requirements of TPS for the development as defined in Article 12, Traffic Performance Standards: The improvements are not being required to meet the requirements of TPS. Therefore, the BCC must make the required exception to criteria No. 3 for a road impact fee credit to be granted.

Exceptions to criteria No. 3 may be made upon BCC approval. No exceptions may be made to criteria Nos. 1 and 2.

All of the above improvements will increase the safety of the motorists and indirectly increase the capacity of the roadways.

The estimated impact fee for the Wawa development is \$202,873.55.

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The Engineering Department recommends approval of this roadway impact fee credit, currently estimated to be \$88,200, for the above intersection improvements for the Lantana Road and Military Trail Wawa project. This amount will be adjusted in the future when the final cost of all the improvements has been received.
