I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to:

- A) ratify the signature of the Mayor on the 2018 U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Youth Street Outreach Program Grant Application, for a three (3) year period to be determined by the grantor, in the amount of \$150,000 annually, for the provision of engaging and linking unaccompanied homeless youth to housing and outreach services; and
- **B)** delegate to the County Administrator, or designee, signatory authority on additional forms and any other necessary documents related to the HHS Youth Street Outreach Program Grant Application.

Summary: Federal funding is available for a three (3) year Youth Street Outreach Program that will assist in executing a coordinated community approach to assist unaccompanied homeless youth. The Youth Outreach Team will target unaccompanied youth between the ages of 18-24 years old, with a goal of identifying, engaging, and linking youth to housing and/or services. The Division of Human and Veteran Services (DHVS), serving as the lead agency, is collaborating with the Palm Beach County Youth Services Department and Gulfstream Goodwill Industries, Inc. (Gulfstream Goodwill). A minimum 10% match amount is required per grant regulations and Gulfstream Goodwill will support the match requirement with in-kind services in the amount of \$61,050 annually for a three (3) year period. **No County match funds are required**. The emergency signature process was utilized because there was insufficient time to submit this grant application through the regular agenda process. (Division of Human and Veteran Services) Countywide (HH)

Background and Justification: During the 2017 Palm Beach County Point in Time (PIT) count, 1,608 individuals were counted as homeless and 99 of those were youth ages 18-24. Recent data collected through the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) indicates 275 parenting youth and 100 unaccompanied youth made contact with the Adult Homeless Navigation System within the last nine months. These numbers represent a 79% increase in the number of youth homelessness in Palm Beach County. Street Outreach is a critical part of the homeless services delivery system and with the increased number of homeless youth, a Youth Outreach Team is needed.
