Summary: Amendment No. 1 extends the term of the Contracts for low voltage services for one (1) year through September 12, 2019. The Board originally approved the annual Contracts on September 13, 2016 with an original term of two (2) years with three (3) – one year renewal options. On May 15, 2018, the Board approved increasing the capacity to a cumulative of \$2,600,000. During the first two years of the Contracts, the County awarded \$579,107 in work orders. Projects are bid among the pre-qualified participants. Firms may become pre-qualified and join the bidding pool at any time during the term or renewals. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance is 15%. The cumulative SBE participation for all work orders to-date is 44.99%. (Capital Improvements) Countywide (LDC)

**Background and Justification:** Twelve (12) contractors were originally pre-qualified to provide low voltage services associated with repairs and/or improvements to County properties. The original list of twelve (12) approved participants was reduced to ten (10), where an additional seven (7) contractors were then added. Work is awarded as work orders on a lump-sum, competitively quoted basis among the pool of pre-qualified low voltage contractors. The original contract terms were for two (2) years and allowed for three (3) additional one (1) year renewals. This will be the first renewal. It is the consensus of Facilities Development and Operations that these contractors have successfully provided the services required by the County in a timely manner. They are in good standing and wish to continue to provide services.
