Background and Justification: WUD's Uniform Policies and Procedures require Standard Development Agreements to obtain concurrency for water and/or wastewater service. The terms and conditions for Standard Development Agreements are outlined in the WUD Uniform Policies and Procedures Manual. The BCC delegated the authority to execute various types of Standard Development Agreements, and related documents including Standard Indemnity Agreements to the Department Director including potable water and wastewater agreements (R93-1619); reclaimed water agreements (R96-0228); and additional conditions for potable water, wastewater, and reclaimed water agreements (R2003-0539).

The Agreements have been executed on behalf of the BCC by the Director of WUD in accordance with the authority delegated by the BCC, and are now being submitted to the BCC to receive and file.

- A) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with SFD Lyons, LLC, #09-01080-001 (District 5). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located at Southeast corner of Atlantic Avenue and Lyons Road, 58.00 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERC's) for both water and wastewater for five (5) years.
- B) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with Cobblestone Plaza at Boynton, LLC, and Springs Equity, LTD, as Tenants in Common, SDA #05-01117-000 (District 5). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located in the Northeast Corner of Boynton Beach Boulevard and Lyons Road, 147.80 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERC's) for both water and wastewater for five (5) years.
- C) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with Kennedy Homes, LLC, #01-01248-000 (District 2). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located 1000' South of intersection of Summit Boulevard and Ranchette Road, 45.50 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERC's) for both water and wastewater for five (5) years.

Change Order No. 3 was approved by the Contract Review Committee on November 8, 2017 in the amount of \$78,706.00 and provided for a 7-day time extension. Change Order No. 4 was approved by the Contract Review Committee on January 24, 2018 in the amount of \$22,200.00 and provided for a 30-day time extension. Change Order No. 6 was approved by the Contract Review Committee on May 31, 2018 and provided for a 90-Day time extension to the Final Completion Only. The cumulative time extension including Change Orders 3, 4 and 6 is 127 days. County PPM CW-F-050 requires Board notification when the cumulative limit of one hundred twenty (120) days has been reached to reset the applicable time limit approvals.


