A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TO JOIN THE SOUTHEAST SUSTAINABILITY DIRECTORS NETWORK AND RESILIENCY FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County ("the Board") adopted Resolution No. 2017-0834 on June 20, 2017, to create the Office of Resilience to serve as a resource, catalyst, and advocate for Palm Beach County ("the County") climate resilience planning, implementation activities, and sustainability efforts; and

WHEREAS, Southeast Florida is one of the most vulnerable areas in the country to the impacts of climate change, especially sea level rise; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to join the Southeast Sustainability

Directors Network to build the County's resilience capacity to advance innovative policies and
programs; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to join Resiliency Florida so that the County aligns and collaborates with public and private partners to promote state and regional resilient strategies and action plans and advocate for increased state and federal investment in critical infrastructure and habitats; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of Resilience recommends that the County join both the Southeast Sustainability Directors Network and Resiliency Florida to advance County resilience priorities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby adopted and ratified.

Section 2: The Board hereby authorizes the Clerk to disburse funds of \$750 for Southeast Sustainability Directors Network membership and \$2,000 for Resiliency Florida membership.
