
Summary: Only one company met the SBE goal in the compliance review, but it fell outside the range for the ranking of responsive bidder consideration. Eastman Aggregate Enterprises, LLC (Eastman), a Palm Beach County company, was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder with 0.016% SBE participation. Rio-Bak Corporation (Rio-Bak), a Palm Beach County company, was the next lowest responsive, responsible bidder with no SBE participation. Both contractors offered to increase their SBE commitment in the Contracts to 15%. Eastman's revised SBE Schedules have been added to the contract. Rio-Bak's SBE subcontractor updated its services' certification with the County, rendering it eligible. The initial contract term is two years, which may be extended for an additional one year upon approval by the BCC. Districts 1, 4, 7 (DC)

Background and Justification: ERM typically performs dune/beach restoration work between November and February due to sea turtle nesting season restrictions. The Invitation for Bid notified bidders that the County could award two contracts and assign work orders at its discretion. The Invitation for Bid also estimated quantities of bid items for each anticipated project; the contract price is based on those quantity projections for the first two years. The County developed an Engineer's Estimate using the closest approved sand mine source. This closest sand mine could not commit to the estimated sand quantities at the time of bidding. As such, the two lowest bids include sand mine sources located further than the source used in the County's estimate. This additional distance accounts for the two lowest bids exceeding the estimate by 12% and 18%. Staff recommend that the two lowest contractors' bid pricing be accepted. The County will assign a project to the contractor with the lowest work order price. The contractor may decline a work order prior to execution. A Public Construction Bond is required prior to the execution of the first work order. Each contract has an annual CPI-indexed price escalation clause capped at 3%.
