I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF
Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:
<b>A)</b> Subaward Amendment 4, No. 9920160083 with the RAND Corporation, for the performance period September 1, 2017, through August 31, 2019, in an amount not to exceed \$258,173.49, to continue improving health outcomes for persons living with HIN Spectrum Disease; and
<b>B)</b> FY 2018 downward Budget Amendment of \$59,192, in the Ryan White Care Program fund to align budget to actual grant award.
Summary: On March 1, 2016, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) ratified the Ryal White Part A, Data Integration Grant Application (R2016-0239) with the RAND Corporation for the maximum cumulative amount of \$317,365 for a three year contract. Start recommends approval of this amendment, which will extend the contract through August 31 2019, with a revised maximum cumulative amount of \$258,173.49, which includes the develobility of unused prior year amounts and carryover funding of \$37,800. On August 16 2016, the BCC ratified the first of three (3) Subaward Agreements. The second agreement was approved on January 10, 2017. The third agreement was approved on November 21 2017. This is the fourth and last of the agreements which represents a revised cumulative amount of \$258,173.49. The Addressing HIV Care Project is a collaboration between the Palm Beach County Community Services Department and the City of West Palm Beach's Department of Housing and Community Development. The funding integrates data management systems between the Ryan White Part A and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) programs. The funds improve the delivery of medical and housing services, improve health outcomes, and coordinate service delivery and quality management through improved data infrastructure for homeless HIV-positive clients. No County funds are required. (Ryan White Program) Countywide (HH)
<b>Background and Justification</b> : The Department of Community Services' Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Part A HIV Emergency Relief Grant Program will improve the coordination of services for the HIV-positive homeless population by coordinating data systems and service planning with the HOPWA program.

## ATTACHMENT 4 Statement of Work and Reporting Requirements (Revised)

### ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

In addition to any reporting requirements stated below in the SOW, the following additional reporting is required:

A final invoice, marked "FINAL", must be submitted to RAND's Financial Contact, no later than 60 calendar days after the Subcontract Total Project Period end date. RAND shall make the final payment to Subcontractor upon RAND Pl's approval and confirmation that the Subcontractor has completed of all required deliverables and reports as indicated in Attachment 4. An annual final invoice, marked "FINAL", must be submitted to RAND's Financial Contact, no later than 60 calendar days after each Annual Budget Period end date stated in the Subcontract. RAND shall make the final payment to Subcontractor upon RAND PI's approval and confirmation that the Subcontractor has completed of all required deliverables and reports as indicated in Attachment 4 for the annual budget period. Subcontractor will provide closeout certifications within 120 calendar days after the end of the project period to RAND's Administrative Contact. The required form(s) will be provided by RAND near the end of the project period. Annual Key Personnel Effort Certification report will be submitted to RAND's Administrative Contact within thirty (30) calendar days П after to the end of each budget period. The required form(s) will be provided by RAND near the end of the project period. Quarterly Monitoring Reports (QMR) detailing the status of progress in relation to the tasks stated in SOW below are due within 30 calendar days of each project quarter ending and are to be submitted via email to submonitoring@rand.org. Failure of the Subcontractor to submit these reports may be considered noncompliance and result in RAND taking enforcement action against noncompliant subcontractors as described in 2 CFR 200.338-Remedies For Noncompliance. Subcontractor will participate in Quarterly Post-Award (QPA) Check-Ins with RAND, to be scheduled by RAND at a later time.
