Summary: The Contract with West Program Phase 1 and 2 project at La Calendar Days was approved by the Bo in the amount of \$90,020.51 and 17 authorities detailed in PPM CW-F-050	antana <i>A</i> pard on . 9 Caler	Airport in the ar July 11, 2017 (R ndar Days were	mount 2-2017- e appr	0935). Change Orders 1-7 in the amount of \$90,020.51 and 179 Calendar Days were approved under the delegated authorities detailed in PPM CW-F-050. Approval of Change Order No. 8 will increase the contract to \$6,554,130.82 and increase the Contract time for substantial completion to 599 Calendar Days. The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Goal for this project was established at 11%. The DBE to date participation for this contract is 2.8%. The DBE participation is primarily in later phases of this contract. DBE participation for this Change Order is 18.7%. Countywide (AH)

Background and Justification: Approval of Change Order No. 8 will provide compensation to the Contractor for nine (9) Contract Change Proposals as detailed in the Change Order Exhibit 1. The changes are primarily due to agency review comments, airfield signage improvement to enhance safety and increases in materials cost caused by the tariffs enacted in March of this year. The agency review added a requirement that in addition to the fire rated wall panels that were included in the project that the interior structural members of the building be protected by a 2-hour Spray Fire Resistive Material (SFRM). The contractor has also submitted documentation supporting cost increases to the metal building due to the tariffs on imported steel and aluminum effective in March of 2018 after the bid opening and prior to the release of the building for production.

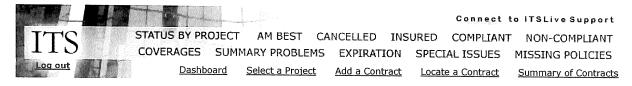
