Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to:

(A) Approve the filing of the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Grant Application 1098-2017-1 for capital funds allocated to Palm Beach County in the amount of \$1,500,000 with an anticipated start date of January 2, 2019 and an anticipated end date of April 10, 2022;

(B) Approve the filing of Standard Form LLL - Disclosure of Lobbying Activities;

(C) Authorize the County Administrator or designee to electronically submit and execute on behalf of the BCC, and to transmit electronically the BCC's approval of the Grant Application, award, and the resulting grant agreement.

Summary: On June 15, 2017, the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency (TPA) adopted the Fiscal Years 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) which identifies transportation priorities for the County. Included in these priorities is the expansion of Palm Tran's South County Facility. In support of this initiative, the TPA approved the flexing of \$1,500,000 from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for the construction cost of the expansion and those funds are now available for grants to be awarded through the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). This application has a match requirement of \$375,000 or twenty-percent (20%) of the total award. The source of the matching funds are Toll Revenue Credits provided by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). Execution of the FTA award represents the County's legal affirmation to adhere to FTA and other federal requirements as described in the Master Agreement FTA MA (24) dated October 1, 2017, approved by the Board on April 10, 2018 under item 3-AA1. **No County funds are required.** <u>Countywide</u> (DR)

Background and Policy Issues: The South County Expansion is estimated to cost \$25 million per the ninety-five percent (95%) engineering plans estimate and will be fully funded with federal funds. The project is slated to begin Spring 2019. The design process is completed and currently under permit review by the City of Delray Beach. The County has received sealed bids from subcontractors and the Construction Manager at Risk, Morganti, Inc., who is currently in the process of drafting the final Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for the project. The expected completion date of the project is January 2020. The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), of which the expansion project is an identified priority, is a staged program encompassing a five-year period, consisting of all regionally significant transportation improvements to all modes of travel in Palm Beach County. The TIP is developed by the TPA through a continuing, cooperative, comprehensive and coordinated effort involving the Florida Department of Transportation Authority (Tri-Rail) and municipalities within the County. The FTA Master Agreement contains the standard terms and conditions governing the administration of the Project that FTA has financed with Federal assistance.

Award Executive Summary Palm Beach County is a Designated Recipient of 5307 funding. This application is for \$1,500,000 in Flex Funds. The grant will fund the planned expansion of Palm Tran's South County Facility, located in Delray Beach, FL.

On June 15, 2017, the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency (TPA) adopted the 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) which identifies transportation priorities for the County. Included in these priorities is the Expansion of Palm Tran's South County Facility. In support of this initiative, the Florida Department of Transportation

(FDOT) approved \$1,500,000 for the construction cost of the expansion, and those funds are now available for grant award through the FTA.

The funds awarded under this grant will be spent as follows:

1) Palm Tran South County Expansion

The South County Expansion Project entails construction consistent with existing land use and zoning requirements (including floodplain regulations) and uses primarily land disturbed for transportation use, such as: buildings and associated structures; bus maintenance facility which are within areas of the right-of-way occupied by the physical footprint of the existing facility or otherwise maintained or used for transportation operations.

This project received concurrence for a categorical exclusion on July 9, 2013 for the renovation and expansion of the Maintenance Facility located in the City of Delray Beach, the scope and details of the project have not changed since the original information was submitted to FTA.

Project Description

Palm Tran is expanding the South County (SC) facility located at 100 N Congress Ave, Delray Beach, FL 33445; to accommodate Palm Tran's growth. Both North and South County facilities are operating beyond capacity. On November 5, 2013, Palm Beach County acquired land adjacent to the SC facility; on March 1, 2016 the contract for architectural and engineering services for the SC expansion was awarded to Colome and Associates Inc., a DBE Company.

The grant will partially fund construction costs for expansion and renovation of the Palm Tran South County Facility which includes: addition of approximately 28,000 square feet of building space consisting of offices, locker rooms, training center for bus operators and ancillary support space, addition of a new 135 vehicle parking lot for employees on the south side, and addition of a bus lift at the existing maintenance building. This grant will cover the cost of construction; future grants will cover the cost of the equipment.

Project Benefits

Project Benefits

In addition to the opportunity to increase the number of parking spaces for both employees and buses, the construction will expand the administration building on the existing South County Facility site to accommodate additional drivers and staff required for the increase in service. This project will include a building expansion to house additional administrative employees and the expansion of dispatch and drivers rooms. The southeast bay of the maintenance garage is currently used to service supervisor/relief vehicles and houses a car lift for this purpose. A new car-only bay will be constructed to free up the existing bay for bus service

This expansion includes the construction of a 28,000 sf structure adjacent to the existing office building. The new structure will have an expected useful life of 40 Years. Reduced fares for the elderly and handicapped will continue to be in effect at all times of operation.
