### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: three resolutions declaring the acquisition of a mix of commercial and residential properties designated as parcels 101, 102, and 103 as fee simple road right-of-way, and parcels 301 and 302 as temporary construction easements necessary for the construction of roadway improvements at the intersection of West Linton Boulevard and South Military Trail (Project).

SUMMARY: Adoption of these resolutions will initiate eminent domain proceedings pursuant to Chapters 73, 74, 127, and Section 337.27, Florida Statutes as amended, against three commercial and two residential parcels having a total appraised value of \$292,756. The parcels are necessary for the construction of northbound and southbound right turn lanes. The Project includes resurfacing of the intersection, the installation of drainage, sidewalks, and an updated traffic signal at the intersection of West Linton Boulevard and South Military Trail. To date, the property owners have not accepted the offers to purchase made by Palm Beach County (County) and attempts to negotiate the purchases have been unsuccessful. Eminent domain proceedings are necessary to acquire the residential and commercial parcels at this time in order to expedite construction of the Project, which is funded in the current Five Year Road Program. **Background and Justification:** The acquisition of parcels 101, 102, 103, 301, and 302 is for a public purpose and necessity, which is deemed to be in the best interest of the County. The Engineering Department recommends the Board of County Commissioners' approval.
